Tips for the upcoming Virtual Meeting

For those who are unfamiliar with Zoom, it is a new video chat application. You can download it ahead of time or just follow the link below. You can try to login ahead of time to try it out. There will be no active chatroom, but you can test to make sure everything is working ahead of time.

Rather than just calling in, everyone is encouraged to either use the weblink or download the Zoom app ahead of the meeting to be able to better see and share the video content.

We will ask people to do "show and tell" - so plan to have either your plants nearby to share live pics or take pics ahead of time to share.

The following devices all will work: Desktop computer, PC or Mac, Tablets, Cell Phones, and even flip phones will work if you just call the phone number. If the device has a camera and a microphone you can use it.

Sometimes your PC may not have a microphone and in that case you can still use the computer and monitor and call in on the phone with the phone number. If you do this make sure to turn off the computer speakers to avoid feedback.





• Faye - online show "hosting" idea - some interest from board, but needs more development to be feasible.


Next Board Meeting: Monday May 11th, 2020 - Zoom Meeting, to be scheduled to start at 7:00 pm.






Special Pricing \$60.00 for SFOS Members!


