26	1. The Court, for purpose of this Ge	neral Judgment of Dismissal, adopts all defined

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- terms set forth in the Agreement, and incorporates them herein by reference as if fully set forth herein and having the full force and effect of an Order of this Court.
- 2. The Court hereby dismisses the Second Amended Complaint filed on March 9, 2022, on the merits and with prejudice, with each Party to bear their own costs, except as provided in the Final Approval Order or the Agreement.
- 3. By this General Judgment of Dismissal and as of the Effective Date of the
 Agreement, the Plaintiffs and all members of the Settlement Class shall have, by operation of the
 Final Approval Order and this General Judgment, fully, finally, and forever released,
 relinquished, and discharged Defendant from all Released Claims pursuant to Paragraphs 5.1, 5.2
 and 5.3 of the Agreement.
 - 4. Upon the Effective Date, each and every Settlement Class Member, and any person actually or purportedly acting on behalf of any Settlement Class Member, is hereby permanently barred and enjoined from commencing, instituting, continuing, pursuing, maintaining, prosecuting, or enforcing any Released Claims (including, without limitation, in any individual, class or putative class, representative or other action or proceeding), directly or indirectly, in any judicial, arbitral, or other forum, against the Released Parties. This permanent bar and injunction is necessary to protect and effectuate the Agreement, the Final Approval Order and this General Judgment of Dismissal, and this Court's authority to effectuate the Agreement, and is ordered in aid of this Court's jurisdiction and to protect its judgments.
 - 5. The Court reserves continuing and exclusive jurisdiction over this Action, the Plaintiffs and the Settlement Class for the purposes of supervising the interpretation, implementation, and enforcement of the Agreement.
 - 6. In the event that the Settlement does not become effective in accordance with the terms of the Agreement, then this General Judgment of Dismissal shall be vacated *nunc pro tunc* and, in such event, all orders entered and releases given in connection herewith shall be null and void.

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1	7. This General Judgment of Dismissal is intended to be a final disposition of the		
2	Action in its entirety and is intended to be immediately appealable and fully and finally resolves all claims in this Action.
