ECPRD Network (1)

The ECPRD (European Centre for Parliamentarian Research and Documentation) was founded as a joint initiative of the European Parliament and the Parliamentary Assembly of the Council of Europe (PACE).

It acts as a network for information exchange between parliaments in Europe.





ECPRD Network (2)

Established in 1977 at the request of the speakers of European Parliamentary Assemblies, actual members of the ECPRD are from

3 international institutions

47 member states (59 chambers)

and 4 countries have Observer-status

ECPRD Network (3)

Structure:

- two co-directors,
 each of whom assisted by a co-secretary;
- the Conference of Correspondents;
- the Executive Committee.

The secretariat of the ECPRD is provided by the EP, who also develops and hosts the ECPRD website.





... but generic usernames exist for all chambers, to allow all staff to be able to read the information on the website




Site structure



Parliamentary Practice and Procedure

Release of the book "Parliament & Judiciary" On 8 and 9 November 2007, the legal departments of the Belgian House of Representatives and the Belgian Senate organised, within the framework and with the collaboration of ECPRD, a European seminar in Brussels on the relationship between Parliament and Judiciary. The seminar covered the judicial review of Parliament's acts by focusing on four selected themes: (1) search and seizure in the precincts of the Parliament, (2) representation at law of parliamentary assemblies, (3) judicial review of acts accomplished by Parliament in the exercise of key parliamentary functions, and (4) judicial review of acts accomplished by Parliament outside the scope of key parliamentary functions. All seminar proceedings were compiled in a conference book, which was released this week in English ("Parliament & Judiciary") and in French ("Parlement & Pouvoir judiciaire"). Publication du livre « Parlement et Pouvoir judiciaire » Les 8 et 9 novembre 2007, les services juridiques de la Chambre des représentants et du Sénat de Belgique ont organisé à Bruxelles, dans le cadre et avec la collaboration du CERDP, un séminaire européen consacré aux relations entre le parlement et le pouvoir judiciaire. Ce séminaire a permis d'examiner la problématique du contrôle juridictionnel des actes des parlements par le biais de quatre thèmes choisis : (1) les perquisitions et saisies dans les locaux du parlement, (2) la représentation en justice des assemblées parlementaires, (3) le contrôle juridictionnel des actes accomplis par le parlement dans le cadre de l'exercice des fonctions parlementaires essentielles, (4) le contrôle juridictionnel des actes accomplis par le parlement en dehors de l'exercice des fonctions parlementaires essentielles. Les travaux du séminaire ont été relatés dans un ouvrage qui vient de paraître cette semaine en français (« Parlement & Pouvoir judiciaire ») et en anglais (« Parliament & Judiciary »).
