Guidelines for choosing fresh vegetables and fruits

- Green leafy vegetables must be a deep green colour as this shows the presence of vitamins and iron.
- The leaves of the vegetable must be crisp, which is a sign of freshness.
- In the case of cabbages and leek, the leaves must be firm on the inside.
- Avoid vegetables that have their stems heavily ripened, as this may indicate that the vegetables are no longer fresh.
- Some vegetables must be firm and free from marks. Avoid those that are soft.
- Avoid very large root vegetables, as they may be starchy or have a coarse texture.
- Vegetables must not be bruised or damaged, as this can cause a loss of nutrients, especially water-soluble vitamins B and C.
- Choose fruits that are clean, brightly coloured and free from blemishes.
- Avoid overripe fruit - choose when just ripe.
- Buy fruits that are firm to the touch and are heavy in weight for their size.
- Fruits must not be bruised or damaged, as this can lead to a loss of nutrients, especially water-soluble vitamins B and C.

Storing vegetables and fruits

Here are some guidelines on how to store vegetables and fruits to prevent spoilage and loss of nutrients:

- Store roots and tubers in a dark, cool, dry place. This prevents moulding and sprouting. They can also be stored in plastic bags or sealed plastic containers to prevent them from drying out and losing nutrients.
- Put green tomatoes in a bowl on a sunny windowsill or ripen. Once ripe they can be stored in the refrigerator.
- Vegetables such as carrots, peas and green beans can be washed, peeled, chopped and frozen. This will keep nutrients locked in for up to six months, provided they are stored in airtight containers.
- Vegetables such as onions, leeks, bean sprouts and pumpkin leaves can be par-boiled and then stored. Although there is some nutrient loss, this method allows these vegetables to be available when out of season.
- Check stored fruit and vegetables regularly and remove those that show signs of decay as this can spread very easily. The best of produce should be quickly in freezing, fruit and vegetables.

Guidelines for choosing and storing meat

- The meat should look red and moist.
- Beef should be red in colour and not should be pink in colour.
- Look meat should have **no** fat.
- Meat should be springy to the touch.
- Meat should be stored in a cool, dry place, for example in a plastic bag or sealed plastic container to prevent them from drying out and losing nutrients.
- Direct meat (steak) should show no signs of mould.
- Check the expiry date on packaged meat. It should be replaced by the meat that is already beyond its 'sell by' date.
- Buy meat from a reputable supplier that sells meat that has been inspected and graded.
- Direct meat should be stored in the refrigerator and used within a few days after being purchased. Wrap the meat in plastic to keep out air and prevent oxidation of juices.
- Meat can be frozen for up to three months.
- Processed or cured meat, such as ham or poultry can be kept in the refrigerator for up to two weeks, provided it is well covered.
- Direct meat can be stored in the fridge.

Guidelines for choosing and storing eggs

- The egg from a supplier that has a high turnover and checks the 'sell before' date on the container.
- Open the container and examine the egg for cracks.
- There should be no unpleasant smells.
- A crack egg will produce a sound when shaken whereas a fresh egg will not.
- A fresh egg will have a rough shell.
- A fresh egg will be heavier than a stale egg.
- Eggs should be stored in a cool, dry place, for example the egg tray in a refrigerator.
- Eggs should be stored away from strong smelling foods such as onions, as their porous shells may absorb the odour.
- Eggs should be stored with the sharp end facing down and the rounded end facing up to keep the egg yolk suspended in the centre.
- Eggs may also be stored in a container with sawdust or dry vegetable bran.

Guidelines for storing milk

- Milk should be stored in a cool, dark place, for example, a refrigerator.
- Milk should be covered to keep it from absorbing fumes from strong smelling foods, like onions and cheese.
- Fresh milk should be used within 3-5 days after purchase.
- Condensed and ultra-heat-treated milk should be stored in fresh milk once the packet is opened.

Guidelines for storing cheese

- Cheese should be stored in the refrigerator.
- Soft cheese will keep for a few days in the refrigerator.
- Hard cheese will keep for weeks if it is kept in a sealed container or tightly wrapped in airtight plastic.

Crafts

- Baskets** is one of the oldest crafts in the world. The most common types are called, placid, cane and straw, and split baskets.
- Pottery** is a traditional craft that has been used for many years by all groups of Botswana to make both functional and decorative articles. This shows how wise to hand built the pots are by the potters, and they naturally.
- They can be used in many different ways to improve the home. Examples are fabric, pottery, stained glass, stained glass, pottery on canvas, pottery on glass, wood, paper and paper mache.
- Carving into primitive ornaments. Wood, soapstone, clay, bone, plaster, shell and wax can be carved.
- An easy way to make a picture is to cut a **stencil**, by sticking natural or man-made materials on to a firm background.
- In southern Africa many groups of people traditionally carried out **handicrafts**. These can be divided into simple lines, woven to make the fabric, using fibre fabric or cotton to make a design on cloth or leather.



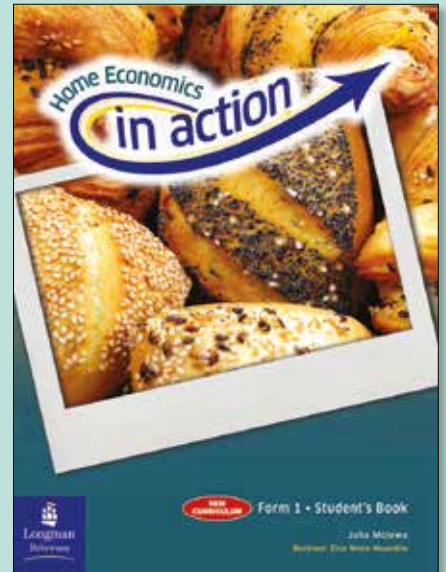


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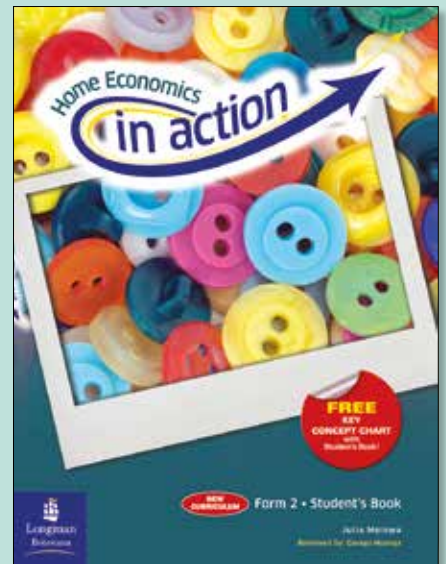
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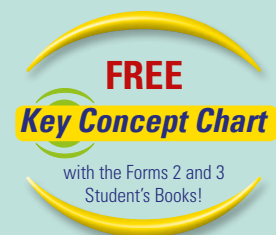
