Tributus is a treasure honoring our land and praising its heritage. The San Andreas fault borders the eastern edge of the Paso Robles Formation across to the rugged coastal mountain ranges on the western border. Gravel, sand, silt, and clay soils create the classic hallmarks of the appellation.

TASTING NOTES

Tributus Paso Robles Cabernet Sauvignon dark purple color with dark fruit flavors with hints of baking spices.

AROMAS: *Cherry, plum, vanilla*

FLAVORS: *Black cherry, dried plum, mocha*

FINISH: *Smooth sweetness, black currant*

WINEMAKING

Alison Crowe, Winemaker

Fermented on the skins at 80°F up to two weeks for color and tannin extraction. Finished in new oak for several months.

VINEYARDS: *Alluvial well-drained soil, certified sustainable*
