### Abstract

*Peperomia nitida* and *P. armondii* (Piperaceae, subgen. *Rhyncophorum*) are recorded for the first time for the Argentinean flora in the province of Misiones. The species are described and illustrated, and their geographical distributions are updated. A key to distinguish the Argentinean species of subgen. *Rhyncophorum* is included, and *P. elongata* is excluded from the Argentinean Flora.
