Abstract

This paper deals with a revised taxonomy of seven neotropical species of the genus *Marattia* (*M. alata*, *M. cicutifolia*, *M. excavata*, *M. interposita*, *M. laevis*, *M. laxa* y *M. weinmanniifolia*), based on morphological characters of the sporophyte, both vegetative and reproductive. A new and detailed description of the species is provided, along with synonymy, comments on habitat, geographical distribution and a complete list of the studied specimens. A key to identify the species is also given
