<u>CIS</u> is an online database from which you can quickly access current regulations, construction standards, technical advice and industry news on building, engineering, design and construction processes in the United Kingdom and Republic of Ireland.

Updated weekly, the CIS offers a powerful search engine to find authoritative information for every stage of the construction lifecycle, from design and completion to operation and ongoing use. Easy-to-use search filters allow you to query 23,000+ documents from 300+ publishers and more.

CIS is particularly useful for: Architecture, Architectural Design and Technology, Building Surveying, Civil Engineering, Construction, Construction Project Management and Construction Law, and Quantity Surveying.

CIS includes valuable and up-to-date construction-related information, including:


- BRE reports and papers

- JCT agreements, contracts and frameworks
- RIBA contracts, guides and documentation
