

भङ्गक mfn. (-कः-का-कं) Who or what breaks, severes, divides, destroys, &c. **भङ्ग** to break, **खुलु** aff.

भङ्गन् mfn. (-ङ्गन्-ङ्गन्-ङ्गन्) Breaking, destroying **भङ्ग**, and **श्रु** aff.

भङ्गन nf. (-नं-नी) 1. Breaking, destroying. 2. Afflicting. 3. Arresting. 4. Causing violent pain. 5. Routing. 6. Removing. **भङ्ग** m. (-नः) Decay of teeth. **भङ्ग** to break, **खुलु** aff.

भङ्गनक m. (-कः) A disease of the mouth, contortion of the lips, and decay of the teeth. **भङ्गन**, and **कन्** added.

भङ्गुर m. (-कः) A tree growing near a temple. **भङ्ग** to break, **उरु** aff.

भट् r. 1st. cl. (भटति) 1. To hold or cherish. 2. To hire or maintain. 3. To speak. (इ) भटि r. 10th cl. (भटयति) To deceive.

भट m. (-टः) 1. A mercenary. 2. A warrior, a soldier, a combatant. 3. A barbarian, or outcaste of a particular tribe. 4. A goblin. **भट** to maintain, aff. **ञच्** । [इल aff.]

भटिच mfn. (-नः-वा-चं) Rosted on a spit, (meat, &c.) **भट** to nourish, **भट्** m. (-टः) 1. A philosopher, a learned man, especially one conversant with the philosophical systems. 2. An enemy. 3. Best excellent. 4. Authority. 5. A bard in general. **भट-तन्** ।

भट्टार mfn. (रः-रा-रं) Worshipful, reverend, entitled to homage or respect : see the next.

भट्टारक mfn. (-कः-का-कं) Venerable, respectable, entitled to reverence or to homage. **भट्टारक** m. (-कः) 1. A sage, a Muni or saint. 2. A deity. 3. (In theatrical language,) A king. 4. The sun. 5. A term especially applied to a Baudd'ha teacher. **भट्ट** to nourish, aff. **क्तिप्**, **ह** to pass, aff. **खुलु**, and **त** changed to **ट**; otherwise with **टलु** to be confused, the same aff. and **लु** changed to **च**; a cherisher and punisher, a distributor of rewards and punishments; again, **भट्ट** said here to mean, authority **च** to go to or obtain, **ञच्** aff. **कन्** added.

भट्टारकवार n. (-रं) Sunday **भट्टारक** and **वार** a day.

भट्टिनी f. (-नी) 1. A queen, not crowned. 2. The wife of a Bra'hman. In plays the word is often used by maids-in-waiting in addressing a queen or princess. **भट्ट** authority : see etymology of the last word, **इनि** and **डोप** affs.

भट्ट (इ) भटि r. 1st cl. (भट्टने) 1. To rally, to deride or treat with merriment. 2. To jest, to joke. 3. To speak. 4. To upbraid, to reprove. r. 1st and 10th cls. (भट्टने भट्टयति-ने) To do an auspicious act.

भट्टिल m. (-लः) 1. A servant. 2. A hero. **भट्ट** a Sautra root, to be happy, Una'di aff. **इलच्** ।

भट्ट r. 1st cl. (भट्टति) To sound, to utter articulate sound, to speak or say. With **प्रति**, to reply.

भट्टित mfn. (-नः-ता-तं) Sounded, spoken, uttered. **भट्ट** to speak, aff. **क्त्** ।

भट्टिति f. (-तिः) Speech, speaking. **भट्ट** to speak, aff. **क्तिन्**, with the augment **इट्**

भट्टाकी f. (-की) The egg plant, (Solarum melongena.) **भट्ट** to nourish, aff. **आक**, and **तुम्** augment. "वेयुण" । [इ. aff. **ञच्** ।

भट्ट m. (-ट्टः) A mime, a jester, a buffoon, an actor. **भट्ट** to deride, **भट्टक** m. (-कः) A wagtail. **भट्ट** added to the preceding.

भट्टन n. (-नं) 1. Armour, mail. 2. War, battle. 3. Evil, wickedness, mischief. **भट्ट** to blame, &c., aff. **खुलु** [delights.]

भट्टहासिनी f. (-नी) A whore, a harlot. **भट्ट** a jester, and **हासिनी** who

भट्टि f. (-डिः-डो) 1. A plant, from the wood of which a red dye is prepared; Bengal ma'dda'r, (Rubia manjith, Rox.) 2. A wave. **भट्ट** to be auspicious, &c. aff. **इन्**; also with **कन्** added **भट्टिका**; also **भट्टिरी** and **भट्टोरी** । [भट्टिरी, &c.]

भट्टिर m. (-रः) A tree, (Mimosa sirisha.) f. (-री) Ma'dda'r. **भट्ट** See **भट्टिल**

भट्टिल mfn. (-लः-ला-लं) 1. A messenger, one sent or dispatched. 2. Fortunate, happy, prosperous, auspicious. **भट्ट** m. (-लः) 1. A messenger. 2. An artizan. 3. A tree, (Mimosa sirisha.) **भट्ट** to be happy, &c., Una'di aff. **इलच्**; also **र** being substituted for **ल**, **भट्टिर**, or the short vowel being lengthened, **भट्टील** ।

भट्टिरी f. (-री) The Bengal ma'dda'r tree : see **भट्टि**. **भट्टि** to be auspicious, **इरन्** aff.

भट्टील m. (-लः) The Sirisha tree : see **भट्टिल** । [ककन् aff.]

भट्ट क m. (-कः) A flower, (Bignonia Indica.) **भट्ट** to be auspicious, **भट्ट** (इ) भटि r. 1st and 10th cls. (भट्टति-ने भट्टयति) 1. To do an auspicious act. 2. To be happy, well, prosperous, &c. 3. To shine.

भट्ट mfn. (-नः-नी-नं) 1. Reverend, venerable, worshipped or adored. 2. Brilliant, splendid. **भट्ट** m. (-नः) 1. A Saugata, a Baudd'ha, a heterodox or sceptical philosopher. 2. A devotee, an ascetic. **भट्ट** to be happy or pleased, to shine, Una'di aff. **क्त्**, and the nasal rejected.

भट्टक mn. (-कः-कं) Prosperous, fortunate, auspicious. **भट्ट** to be happy, Una'di aff. **आकन्** ।

भट्ट mfn. (-ट्टः-ट्टा-ट्टं) 1. Happy, prosperous, lucky, propitious. 2. Best, excellent. 3. Pure, pious, virtuous. **भट्ट** n. Subst. (-ट्टं) 1. Prosperity, fortune, happiness. (Adv.) Happy, well, right. **भट्ट** n. (-ट्टः) 1. A fragrant grass, (Cyperus.) 2. Gold. 3. Iron or steel. **भट्ट** nf. (-ट्ट-ट्टी) One of the astrological periods called Karanas, the seventh; also called Vishti, regarded as an unlucky period. **भट्ट** m. (-ट्टः) 1. A name of Si'va. 2. A wagtail. 3. A bull. 4. A heap, a multitude. 5. A description of elephant, one of four classes into which they are divided. 6. Mount Méru. 7. One of the nine persons termed Suklabalas by the Jainas. 8. A title of reverential address. 9. A hypocrite. **भट्ट** f. (-ट्टः) 1. The Ganges of heaven. 2. The ichneumon plant : see **राजा** 3. Indigo. 4. Asclepias pseudosarsa. 5. A shrub, (Poederia foetida.) 6. A medicinal plant, commonly Kayap'hal. 7. A name of the second, seventh, and twelfth days of the lunar fortnight. 8. A female Sakti' or deity of the Jainas. 9. One of the four divisions of the Ganges, according to the Pura'nas, that which flows to the northern Kuru. 10. A tree, (Gmelina arborea.) 11. A cow. 12. Turmeric. 13. Dear. 14. Hypocritical. 15. Head, chief. 16. A term of respect used in addressing ladies. **भट्ट** to be happy, Una'di aff. **रन्** and the nasal rejected.

भट्टक mfn. (-कः-का-कं) 1. Beautiful, pleasing agreeable. 2. Respectable, worthy, estimable. 3. Lucky, fortunate. **भट्ट** n. (-कं) A sort of grass, (Cyperus pertenuis.) **भट्ट** m. (-कः) A sort of pine, (Pinus Devadaru.) **भट्ट** **कन्** added to the last.

भट्टकाली f. (-ली) 1. One the forms of the goddess DURGA. 2. A fragrant grass, (Cyperus pertenuis or rotundus.) **भट्ट** Si'va, **कल्** to approximate, affs. **छच्** and **डोप** ।

भट्टकुच m. (-चः) A golden jar filled with water from a holy place, or with the water of the Ganges and used especially at the consecration of a king. **भट्ट** auspicious and **कुच** a water jar.

भट्टगणित n. (-नं) The construction of magical diagrams.

भट्टगन्धिका f. (-का) A creeping plant, (Asclepias pseudosarsa, the narrow-leaved variety.) **भट्ट** auspicious and **गन्ध** smell, affs. **कन्** and **टाप्**; some copies read **भट्टगन्धिका** in place of this word. "सुसके".

भट्टघट m. (-टः) A vessel from which a lottery is drawn.

भट्टहर mfn. (-रः-रा-रं) Auspicious, conferring happiness or prosperity. **भट्ट** happy and **ह** to make, aff. **खश्** ।

भट्टचूड m. (-डः) A sort of Euphorbia, (E. tirucalli.) **भट्ट** propitious and **चूडा** a crest. "लङ्कासिज्" । [इ. aff. wood.]

भट्टदारु m. (-रुः) A sort of pine, (Pinus Devadaru.) **भट्ट** auspicious and **दारु** wood.

भट्टदाकी m. (-कः) A class of thirty-one medicinal plants and substances. **भट्ट** **दारु** the pine, **आदि** etcetera, **कन्** added.

भट्टनामन् m. (-मा) The wood-pecker. **भट्ट** auspicious and **नामन्** a name.

भट्टपदा f. (-दा) A name given to the 26th and 27th lunar asterisms : see **भट्टपदा** ।

भट्टपर्णा f. (-र्णा) A shrub, (Poederia foetida.) **भट्ट** auspicious, **पर्ण** a leaf, and **दाप्** fem. aff. "मात्वाल" ।
