A HELPING HAND FOR NEEDY PEOPLE IN VIETNAM

Dear Friends,

This summer I went back to Vietnam in August. The temperature was hot and humid. Several areas in the North were flooded or in danger of being flooded. The water level of the Mekong river and its branches were rising and being closely watched. I had just finished teaching summer school the day before I left for Saigon. Yet, I did not expect to have a vacation in Vietnam.

In fact, I started my annual journey right after I arrived in Saigon. My first destination was Saigon ITO hospital where SAP-VN contracts with the hospital to perform corrective surgery. There were 17 children from Vinh Long province awaiting surgery at ITO. I talked with each of them and asked about their problems. Dr. Phuong of ITO hospital explained to me what surgical procedures would be performed to correct the problems. The parents who accompanied their children were happy, appreciative and hopeful. My next stop was Soc Trang province. Here I met 18 children who had surgery earlier this year. Most of them were in rehabilitation stage. Three children were still wearing cast. The responses from the families were very happy and positive.

In Dong Thap, I visited the preschool in Binh Phu, Tan Hong district. The village was 76 km from Cao Lanh. The one-classroom preschool was built by SAP-VN Flood Relief Fund. When the flood season comes, it also serves as the flood shelter for young children. The school was built with prefabricated materials. Currently, there are 28 children in attendance. As I about to leave the school, I saw a young girl among the children who were standing outside and watching us. This girl wore orthopedic leg braces and used crutches. I soon found out that Nguyen Thi Thanh Thuy, the girl's name, was one of SAP-VN's orthopedic surgery recipient. Because of polio, Thuy used to be confined at home. Now she could go to school and play with other children in the neighborhood. I felt so happy for her. The chance encounter also reinforced my belief in the positive impact of SAP-VN's Orthopedic project.

My trip continued on to An Giang where SAP-VN sponsors the construction of another preschool/flood shelter. Then I went on to Lam Dong, Khanh Hoa, Phu Yen, Binh Dinh, Quang Ngai, Da Nang, Ninh Binh, Thai Binh and Nam Dinh. I met with 230 children who received surgery or were about to receive surgery. Looking at their face and their eyes, I saw happiness, appreciation, and hope. Even the children who were to have surgery the next day, I noticed that they were not scared at all. I guessed the children understood that the surgery would help them improve their physical defects. Perhaps that explained why they accepted the operation without fear.

I am often asked about my motivation to volunteer for SAP-VN. The answer is my love and compassion toward the needy and disadvantaged, especially the young, innocent children. I am blessed to live in America, the land of opportunities. As a refugee who started from scratch in America, I've learned that dream can come true if you work hard to realize it. However, things are not the same in third world and underdeveloped countries. I have met many children and people who accept their correctable handicaps just because they don't have money to pay for the surgery cost. With two hundred dollars, you can help realize their dreams. Oh, how beautiful those faces and smiles! Yes, you can make dreams come true.
