Characters:

Palpode ("nose") of prostomium elongate
Eyes present, easily visible on contracted prostomium
First setiger complete
Last (11th) thoracic setiger with relatively long capillary
setae - compare to N. magnus and N. lobatus below
Hoods of abdominal uncini closely appressed to hooks - compare
to N. magnus and N. lobatus below
Methyl green stain pattern without ventral "racing" stripes
