Jassa marmorata

Diagnostic Characters:

G1, carpus, seta at the anterodistal junction of the propodus minute, slightly lateral

G2 of female and small non-thumbed male, palm usually concave

G1, basis without a row of short setae along the length of the anterolateral margin

G2, anterolateral margin of the basis with a row of setae along its length




FIG. 17. Jassa marmorata. Neotype, adult male, major form, 6.7 mm. Barren Islands Marina, Jamaica Bay Wildlife Refuge, Brooklyn, New York, early July 1984, B. Borowsky, collector, NMNS 1984-112. Lateral view.
