Gammaropsis thompsoni

200 Host common @ 80 Stations

Diagnostic Characters:

G2, male, palm nearly transverse, bearing both a medial tooth and a defining tooth

G1, male, segment 2 not anterodistally produced into a lobe

G2, male and female, palm bearing a tooth

Coxa 7, male, greatly expanded

Head lobe produced and distally toothed

G1 and G2, male, margins densely setose

G2, female, palm not excavate

Urosome segments 1 and 2, carinations pointed

Eye large and reniform

Uropod 3 rami subequal

Urosome dorsally cusped

Peraeopods 3 and 4, segments 4 and 5 subequal




Figure 4. Gammaropsis thompsoni (Walker) \circlearrowleft 10.0 mm, jv \circlearrowleft 4.5 mm, \circlearrowleft 8.5 mm, Cape Beale, Barkley Sound, Vancouver Is., B.C.
