## COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

#### SEC ANNOUNCES DEPARTURE OF JOHN H. STURC

The Commission today announced that John H. Sturc, Associate Director of the Division of Enforcement will leave the Commission at the end of April. Mr. Sturc will become a partner in the Washington office of Gibson, Dunn & Crutcher in May. He has been with the Commission for eight years, and has served as an Associate Director for the last six years. (Press Rel. 90-20)

#### CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

#### DOUGLAS RONALD YAGODA PERMANENTLY ENJOINED

The New York Regional Office announced that, on April 5, the Honorable Milton Pollack, Senior Judge of the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York, entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief Against Douglas Ronald Yagoda (Yagoda) by Consent. Yagoda consented to the order without admitting or denying the allegations of the Commission's Complaint. The Final Judgment enjoins Yagoda from violating Sections 10(b) and 14(e) of the Securities Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 and 14e-3.

The Commission's Complaint, filed February 3, 1988, alleges that from approximately October 1985 through March 1986, Yagoda, the senior trader in the Marcus Schloss & Co., Inc. (Marcus Schloss) risk arbitrage department, received material nonpublic information about proposed, anticipated and considered corporate takeovers from various sources, including Michael N. David (David), who was then an associate with a large New York City law firm, and that he caused Marcus Schloss to trade securities based on that information. The Complaint also alleges that on one occasion Yagoda instructed a subordinate at Marcus Schloss to transmit material non-public information concerning a proposed leveraged buyout to David. [SEC v. #### CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

## CHARLES PHILLIP ELLIOTT, WILLIAM H. MELHORN FOUND GUILTY

The Atlanta Regional Office, the Miami Branch Office and the U.S. Attorney for the Southern District of Florida announced that, on March 20, Charles Phillip Elliott

(Elliott) of Isle of Capri, Florida, and William H. Melhorn (Melhorn) of Fort Myers, Florida, were found guilty by a federal jury in the U.S. District Court in Ft. Myers, Florida, of 37 counts of fraud by an investment adviser, securities fraud, mail fraud and conspiracy.

Elliott, doing business as Elliott Enterprises, and Melhorn, the chief executive officer of Elliott Enterprises, were found to have engaged in a fraudulent scheme which raised \$60 million from 940 investors. Among other things, Elliott and Melhorn were found to have made misrepresentations and omissions of material fact, including representing that the investments were collateralized, failing to disclose that monies invested by later investors were used to pay interest on and redeem investments of earlier investors, and representing that interest payments to investors were tax free.

Elliott and Melhorn are scheduled for sentencing before the Honorable Lee Gagliardi on April 28. Each faces a maximum sentence of 200 years imprisonment and approximately \$400,000 in fines.
