

QUICK INSTALLATION GUIDE

Before You Begin...

- Before installing the Display driver, make sure your Windows® Vista, Windows® XP or Windows® 2000 was installed in VGA mode and functions properly.

Hardware Installation

Special Precautions for Installing Your Graphics Card:

- Before touching any electronic parts, discharge the static electricity from your body by touching the internal metal frame of your computer while it is unplugged.
 - Do not remove a card from its anti-static bag until you are ready to install it.
- Whenever you remove a card from your computer, always make sure to place it back in its anti-static container.
- Do not let your clothing touch any electronic parts.
 - When handling a card, hold it by its edges, and avoid touching its circuitry.

- 150 MB of available disk space for full installation
- CD-ROM or DVD-ROM drive
- VGA or DVI-I compatible monitor
- 500 Watt power supply (750 Watt power supply for PNY Quadro FX5600, Quadro FX 4700X2, Quadro FX4600)

Software Installation

1. Uninstall Your Existing VGA Driver

- Remove your existing Display Driver using the 'Add or Remove Programs' Icon in the 'Control Panel'.
- Shut down your computer.

2. Remove Your Existing Graphics Card

Prior to working on your computer, power off the computer and any attached equipment such as a monitor or printer. Unplug your computer and disconnect the monitor cable, but note the slot where the cable was plugged in. Disconnect any other peripheral cables as necessary to enable removing the cover of the computer.

Locate your existing graphics card. Then remove the screw that holds the bracket to the chassis. Remove the card by grasping it on the edges and pulling it out of the slot.

3. Choose an Expansion Slot

If necessary, remove the back cover for the slot you intend to use and save the screw for the mounting bracket of your new PNY Quadro graphics card.

4. Insert the New Card

Position the Quadro graphics card over the expansion slot that coincides with the type of card purchased (PCI-Express x1 / x16 or PCI). Push the card firmly and evenly until it's fully seated into the slot. Replace the screw to secure the bracket of the graphics card to the computer chassis. Replace the cover of your computer.

5. Reconnect the Monitor Cable

The PNY Quadro NVS 280 and NVS 290 have a single DMS59-pin connector. Each DMS59 connector can support two monitors, using the supplied splitter cable (VGA or DVI-I).

The PNY Quadro NVS 440 has two DMS59-pin connectors. Each DMS59 connector can support two monitors, using the supplied splitter cable (VGA or DVI-I).

The PNY Quadro FX 370, FX 550, FX 570 have dual DVI-I connectors.

The PNY Quadro FX 3500, FX 3700, FX 4600 and FX 5600 have dual DVI-I connectors and a standard 3-pin connector for 3D stereo.

The PNY Quadro FX 560, FX 1500, FX 1700 have dual DVI-I and HDTV connectors

The PNY Quadro FX 4600G and FX 5600G have dual DVI-I, one BNC and two RJ45 connectors.

The PNY Quadro FX 4700X2 has four DVI-I connectors and a standard 3-pin connector for 3D stereo.

Additional Power Requirements

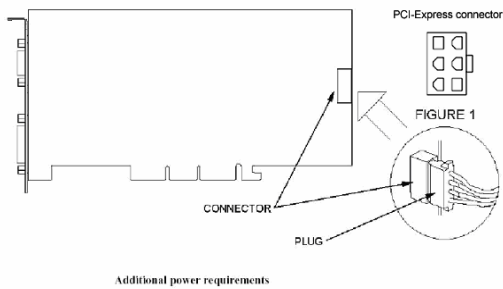
(PNY Quadro FX 3500, FX 3700, FX4600, FX 4600G, FX 5600, FX 5600G cards)

In order for your Quadro FX graphics card to work optimally, an additional power connector must be plugged in. Locate an unused power plug inside your computer system and plug it into the card connector as shown below.

PCI-Express graphics cards need one PCI-Express power connectors (two power connectors for the PNY Quadro FX 5600 and FX 5600G). (Figure 1)

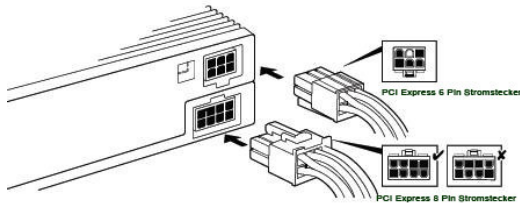
The power connector is keyed so that it can only be inserted one way. Please verify the orientation of the plug before insertion.

DO NOT FORCE IT INTO THE CONNECTOR.



Additional Power Requirements (PNY Quadro FX 4700X2 cards)

The PNY Quadro FX 4700X2 needs two additional power connectors. One additional 6 pins PCI-Express connector and one 8 pins PCI-Express connector. This 8 pins power connector is available in all computer's power supplies manufactured according to PCI-Express Gen.2.0 specifications.



6. Install the Software Drivers

The PNY Quadro CDs contain the software drivers for your new graphics accelerator card. You will also find additional information at www.pny.eu

Installing Quadro Graphics Drivers

1. Insert the PNY Quadro CD-ROM into the CD-ROM drive.
2. Select "Install Drivers". Select the Drivers and Tools that you need to install. Follow the Installation Wizard.
