DO NOT PLANT Non-native Invasive Plants such as the following: Algerian ivy (*Hedera canariensis*), Alta (or Tall) Fescue (*Festuca arundinacea*), Bindweed (*Convolvulus arvensis*), Cape ivy (*Centaurea solstitialis*), Cotoneaster species (*Cotoneaster lacteus* and *C. pannosus*), English Ivy (*Hedera helix*), Fennel (*Foeniculum vulgare*), French Broom (*Genista monspessulana*), Iceplant (*Carpobrotus edulis*), Jubatagrass (*Cortaderia jubata*), Licorice plant (*Helichrysum petiolare*), Mock (or Indian) Strawberry (*Duchesnea indica*), Oxalis pes-caprae (Bermuda buttercup), Pampas Grass (*Cortaderia selloana*), Periwinkle (*Vinca major*), Portuguese Broom (*Cytisus striatus*), Scarlet Wisteria (*Sesbania punicea*), Scotch Broom (*Cytisus scoparius*), Spanish Broom (*Spartium junceum*), Yellow Star Thistle (*Centaurea solstitialis*) and Annual European Grasses.

Do Not Plant Non-native Invasive Trees such as the following: Acacia melanoxylon (Blackwood Acacia), Eucalyptus globulus (Blue Gum Eucalyptus), Edible fig (*Ficus carica*), Saltcedar *Tamarix* spp., Russian olive (*Elaeagnus angustifolia*). Albizia julibrissin, silk tree can be invasive in open areas, may be okay as street tree.
