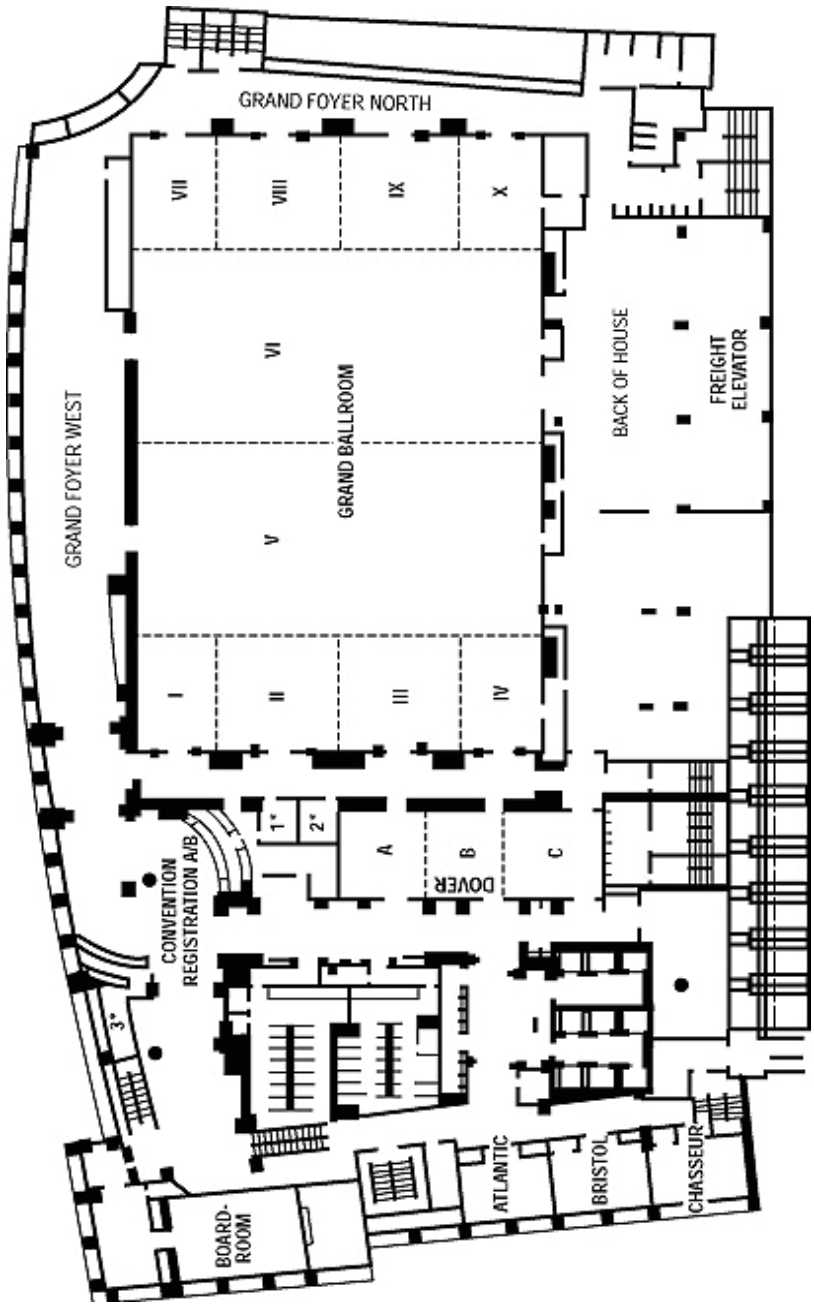

This is the site of Johns Hopkins which is considered by many to be the “father institution for gynecologic surgery”. Howard Kelly, Cullen, Novak, Wharton, Everett, Woodruff, Howard and Georgeanna Jones, TeLinde, and numerous others from Hopkins have made great contributions to our specialty.

This year’s scientific meeting has been moved to a Friday through Sunday format allowing for potentially fewer work days off. Program Director, Dr. John Gebhart, and his committee have assembled a stellar program.

- The Telinde Lecture by Dr. Frank Ling which will be a treat and very meaningful.

- Updates from Vivian Sung on the Systematic Review Group and from Dee Fenner on the status of the Female Pelvic Medicine and Reconstructive Surgery Subspecialty.
- Surgical tips and tricks
- An expanded number of “formal surgical video presentations”
- Three debates which will consider the following:
 - Open versus Endoscopic Myomectomy
 - Surgical alternatives for recurrent pelvic organ prolapse, and
 - Who should be performing surgical management of endometrial cancer.
- Stimulating interactive Roundtable Discussions on Saturday morning

Due to the high quality and quantity of video submissions this year, there will be additional videos available to be viewed in the SurgiView Video Room. Our society has partnered with SurgiView to allow for its members to have an opportunity to view SGS videos as well as numerous other well produced videos, at that their own leisure.

In addition to the SGS general session program, there are industry sponsored educational breakfast symposiums on Friday and Sunday mornings. It is hoped that the addition of these symposiums will provide attendees more opportunities for learning and interaction with colleagues. The goal of the annual scientific meeting is to provide member and non-member attendees with a forum for the latest and most innovative developments in gynecologic surgery. This will be accomplished through lecture, slide, video and poster presentations. Oral presentations are followed by a discussion and a question and answer session.

List the advantages, disadvantages and appropriate indications for transvaginal mesh and laparoscopic surgery in recurrent prolapse surgery
- 3) Discuss the benefits and risks of open vs. laparoscopic myomectomy in gynecologic practice.
- 4) Use evidence based medicine to decide on whether the specialist or generalist should manage endometrial cancer.
- 5) Discuss best practices in informed consent in gynecologic surgery based on recent scientific inquiry.
- 6) Describe etiology and pathophysiology of pelvic floor dysfunction including urinary incontinence, fecal incontinence and pelvic organ prolapse.

Frank W. Ling, M.D.

Frank W. Ling, M.D. is a partner in Women's Health Specialists, a private obstetrics and gynecology practice in Germantown, Tennessee, a suburb of Memphis. He is the Director for the Center for Pelvic Pain Management, which is one of five Centers of Excellence within Women's Health Specialists.

Dr. Ling has been an Oral examiner for the American Board of Obstetrics and Gynecology since 1989 and is currently serving as the Chairman of the Board. He was previously President of the ABOG for a 4 year term. He is a Clinical Professor in the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology at both Vanderbilt School of Medicine and Meharry Medical College. Dr. Ling has been an Active member of the Society of Gynecologic Surgeons since 1993.

In addition, Dr. Ling has been cited annually as one of the “Best Doctors in America” as published by Woodward and White, one of “America’s Top Doctors” by Castle Connolly Medical, and was named one of the “Top 401 Doctors for Women” in the United States by Good Housekeeping. Local honors include the “Good Guy” award in the field of health care for women awarded by the Memphis Women’s Political Caucus and being listed as one of the top physicians in Memphis by Memphis Magazine.

Dr. Ling is a native of Evanston, Illinois and a graduate of Wabash College in Crawfordsville, Indiana. He graduated from University of Texas Southwestern Medical School in Dallas, Texas, and subsequently served an internship in Wilmington, Delaware, and residency at the University of Tennessee in Memphis. He remained on faculty, serving in various roles including Student Clerkship Director, Asst. Dean for Student Affairs, Residency Director, and Director of Gynecology. He was the Chairman of the Department from 1994 through 2003.

His past positions held include: President of the Association of Professors of Gynecology and Obstetrics, President of the Tennessee OB/GYN Society, Chairman of the Tennessee Section of the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists, Chair of the Education Committee for the Council on Resident Education in Obstetrics and Gynecology, Chair of the Liaison Committee for the Council of University Chairs of OB/GYN, member of the Residency Review Committee for Obstetrics and Gynecology and Past President of the APGO Medical Education Foundation..

His publication credits include 38 books edited, over 154 articles and 135 abstracts published, 54 book chapters, and 16 audio/video productions.

Dr. Ling’s clinical interests, beyond student and resident education, include pelvic pain, vulvar vestibulitis, and primary care of women.
