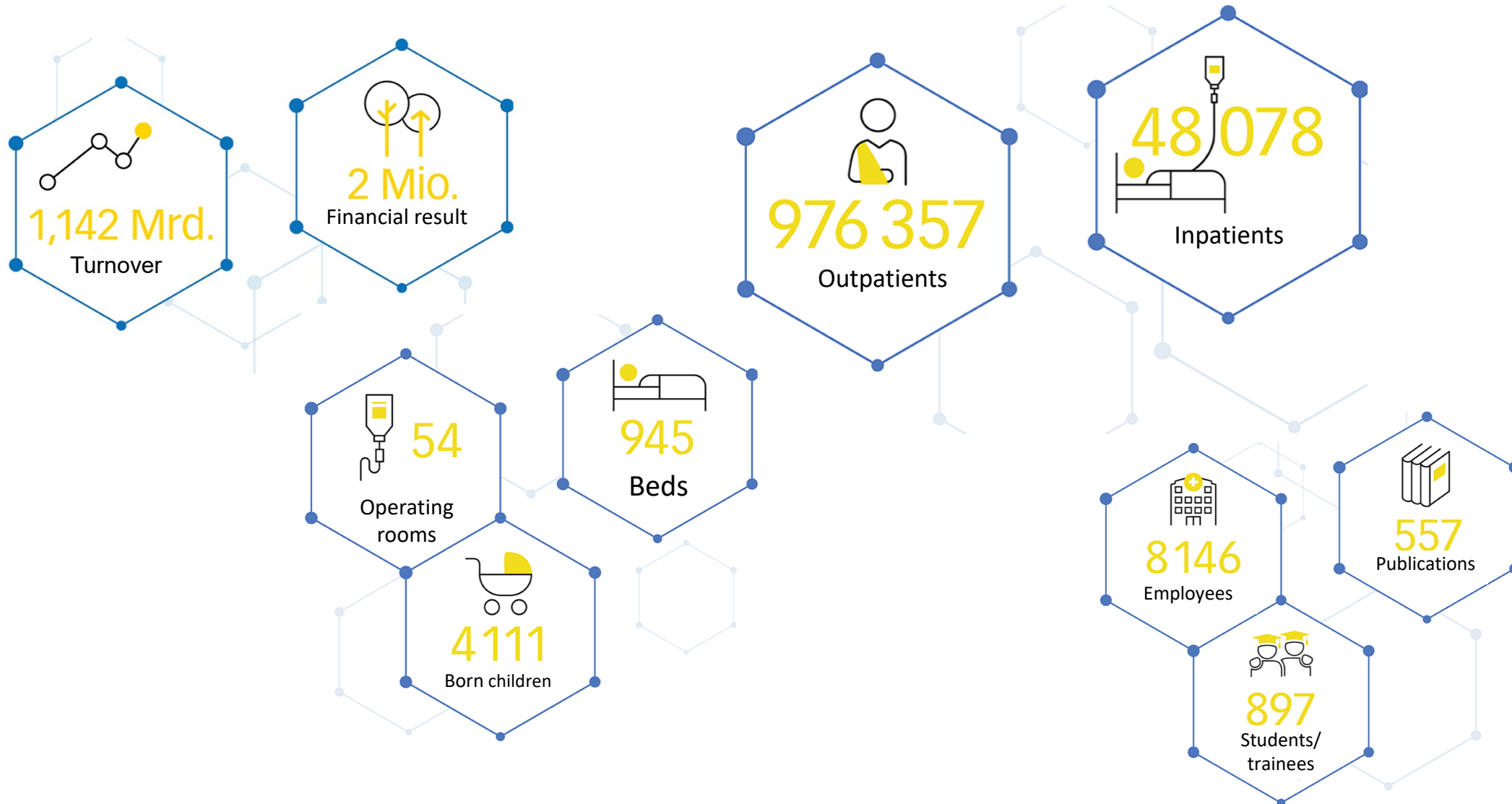


View up direction «Schwanderfluh»



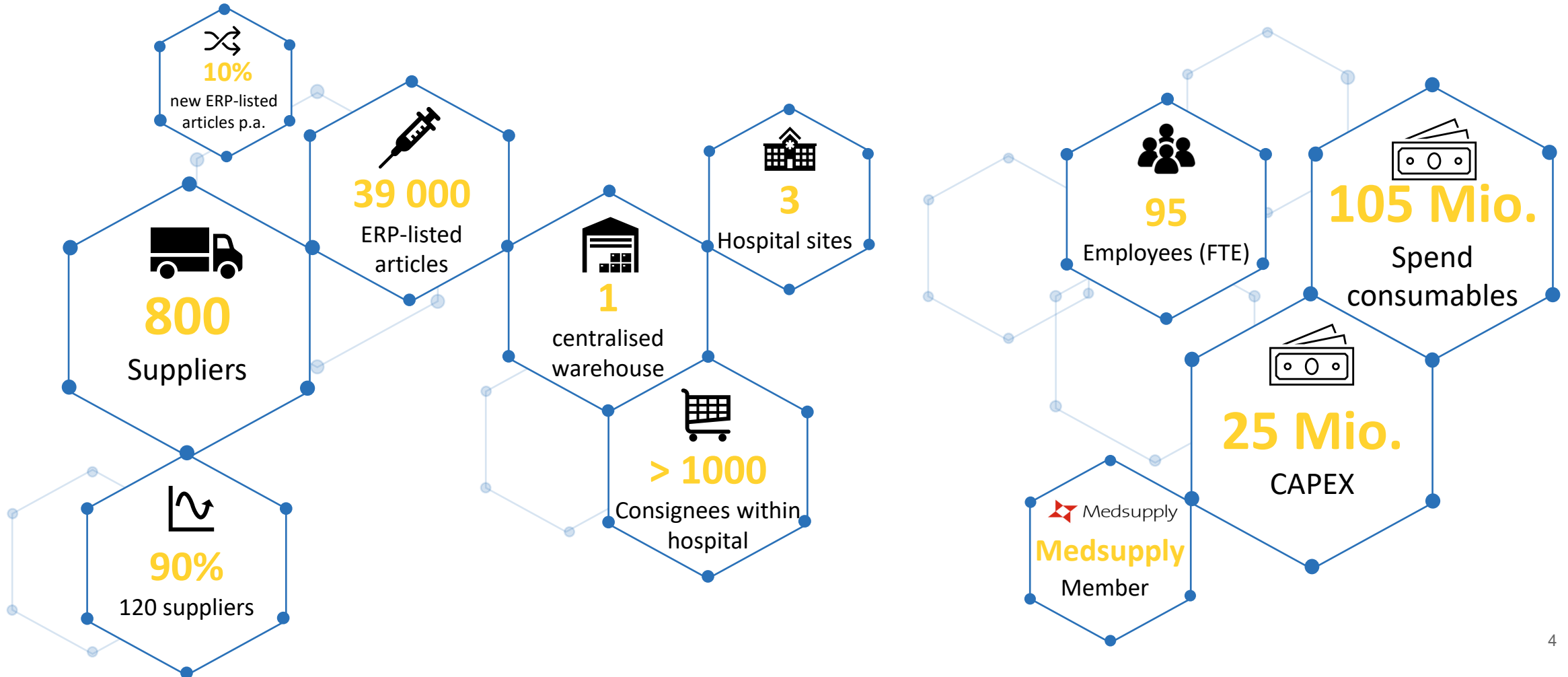
View down from «Schwanderfluh»

MDR is now reality – but what does this mean, exactly?

No MRA with the EU - database which does not work/is not yet accessible

- Revision of the Medical Devices Ordinance (MedDO)
- Changing timeline: MDD (92/42 EWG) to MDR (2017/ 745)
- New economic actors within the meaning of the legislation
- Regulatory requirements leave room for interpretation/are vague
- E.g. Article 65, paragraph 1 MedDO:

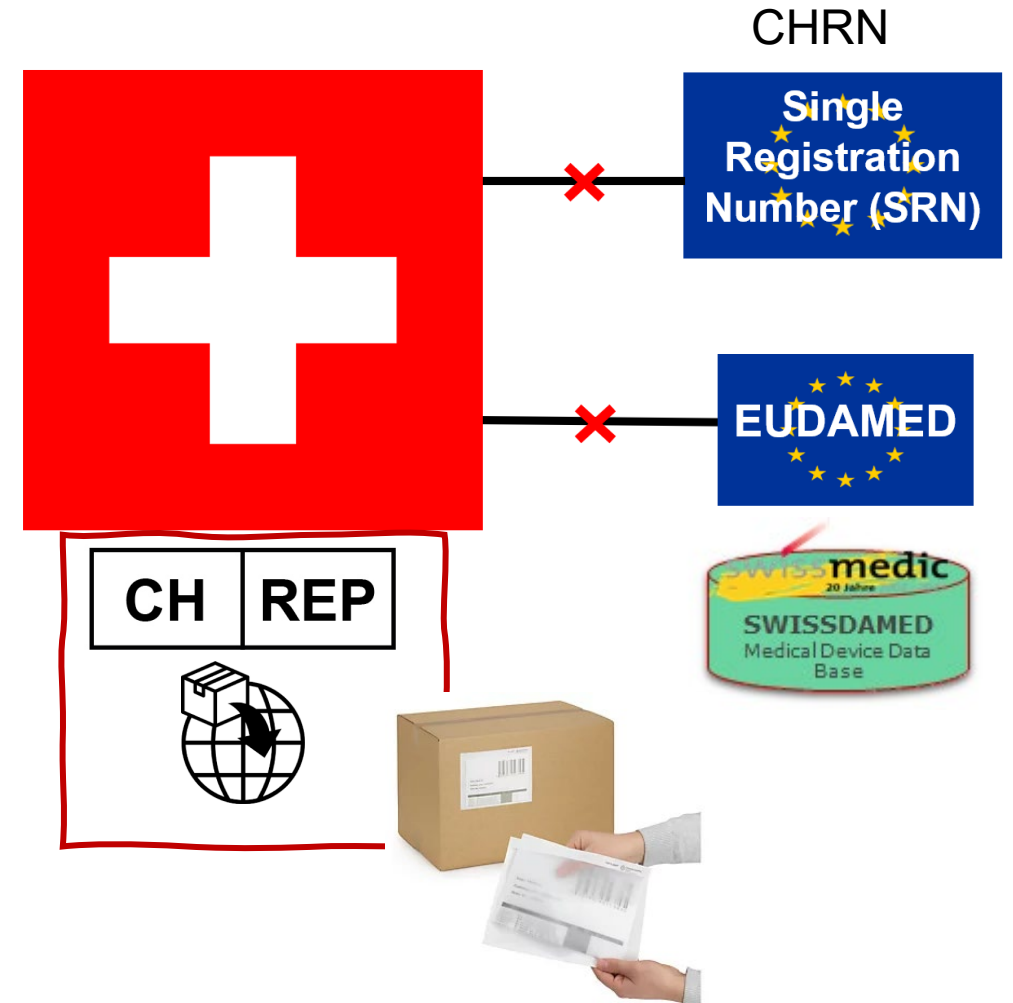
«the healthcare institutions record and store, preferably electronically, the UDI of class III implantable devices they have received or dispensed

 Information from the UDI is already recorded as part of the medical documentation in the Clinical Information System (Krankenhausinformationssystem (KIS))



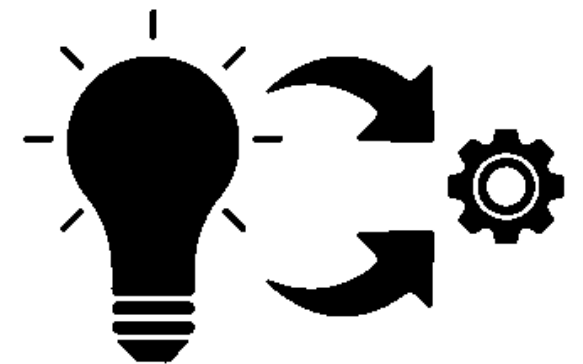
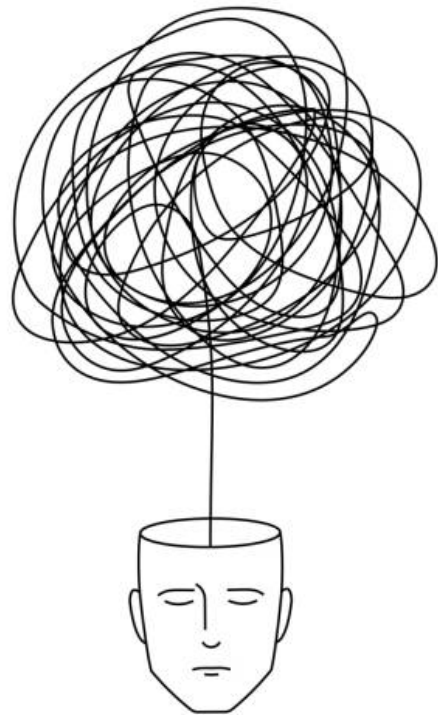

Also without MDR/missing MRA for certain economic actors a headache



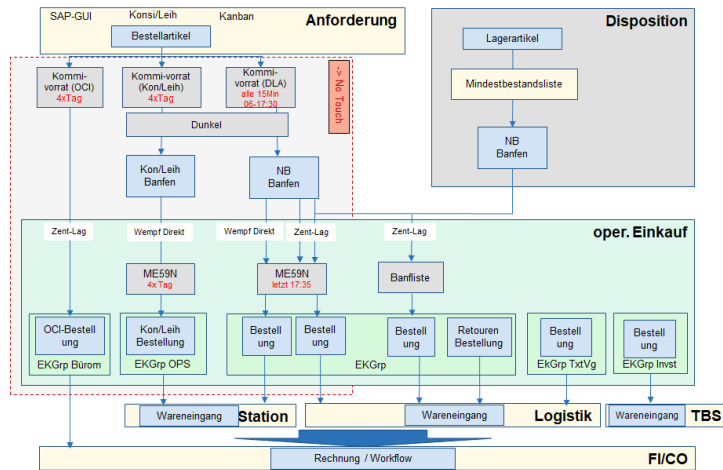

Clear structures/ processes which are not only enforced but also lived by the individuals

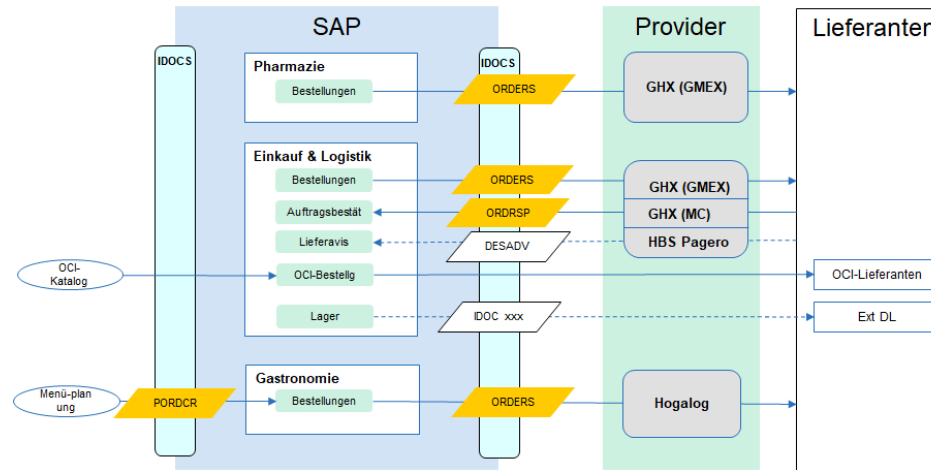

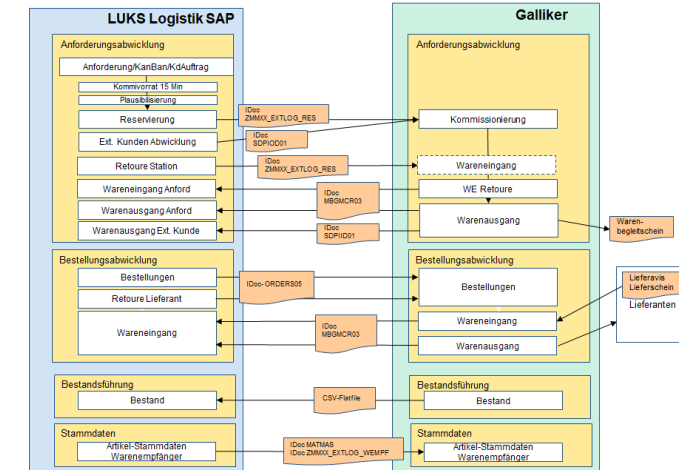
Backbone for a high quality Supply Chain

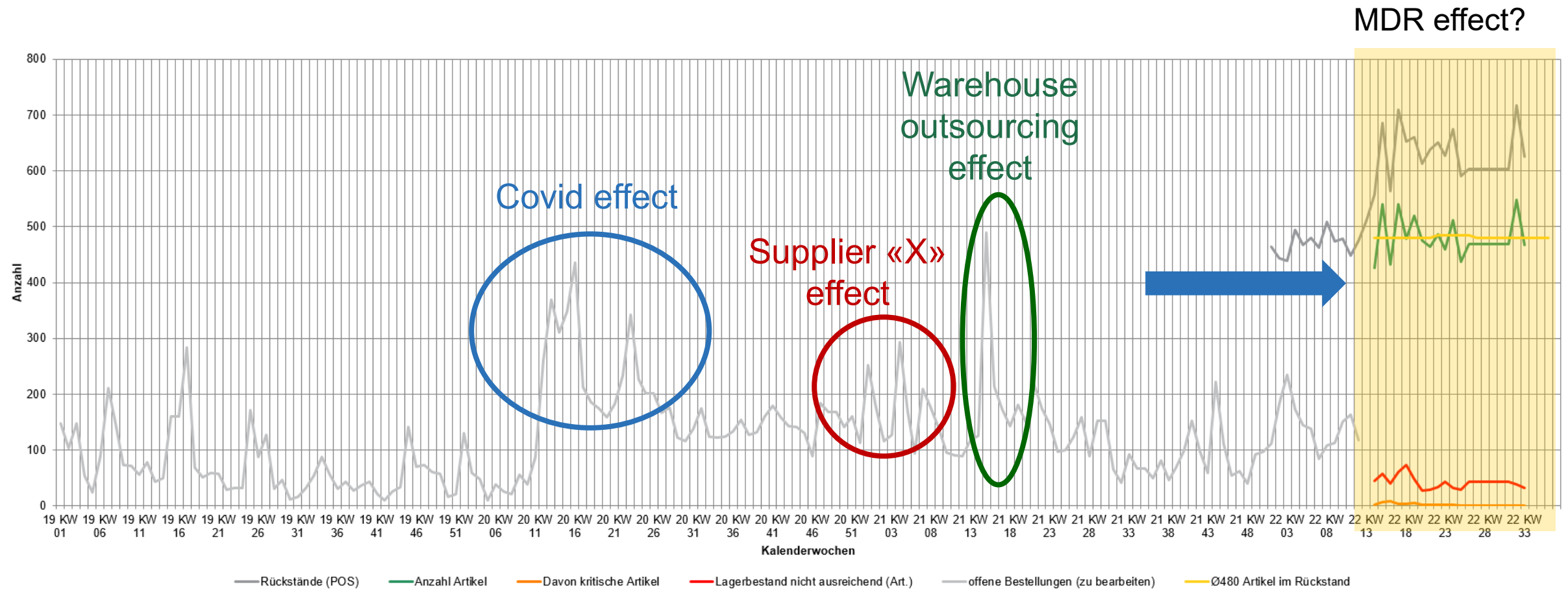

Transparency which needs to be passed on to internal stakeholders – namely doctors and nurses



How do we get a handle on MDR «system-wise»?

Objective: simple tool in SAP

- Assign the following data per article in SAP:
 - Product class
 - Certificate data (Manufacturer, number, type, Notified Body, validity, etc.)
 - UDI
- Certificates are stored in a *structured* way and not as a document
- Data shall be available from
 - EUDAMED or
 - Be queried/ imported from a Swiss-specific database
- Temporary solution: Export data via csv. File and re-import again (mass upload)

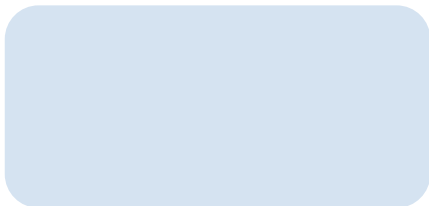
Implementation in SAP – Data Model

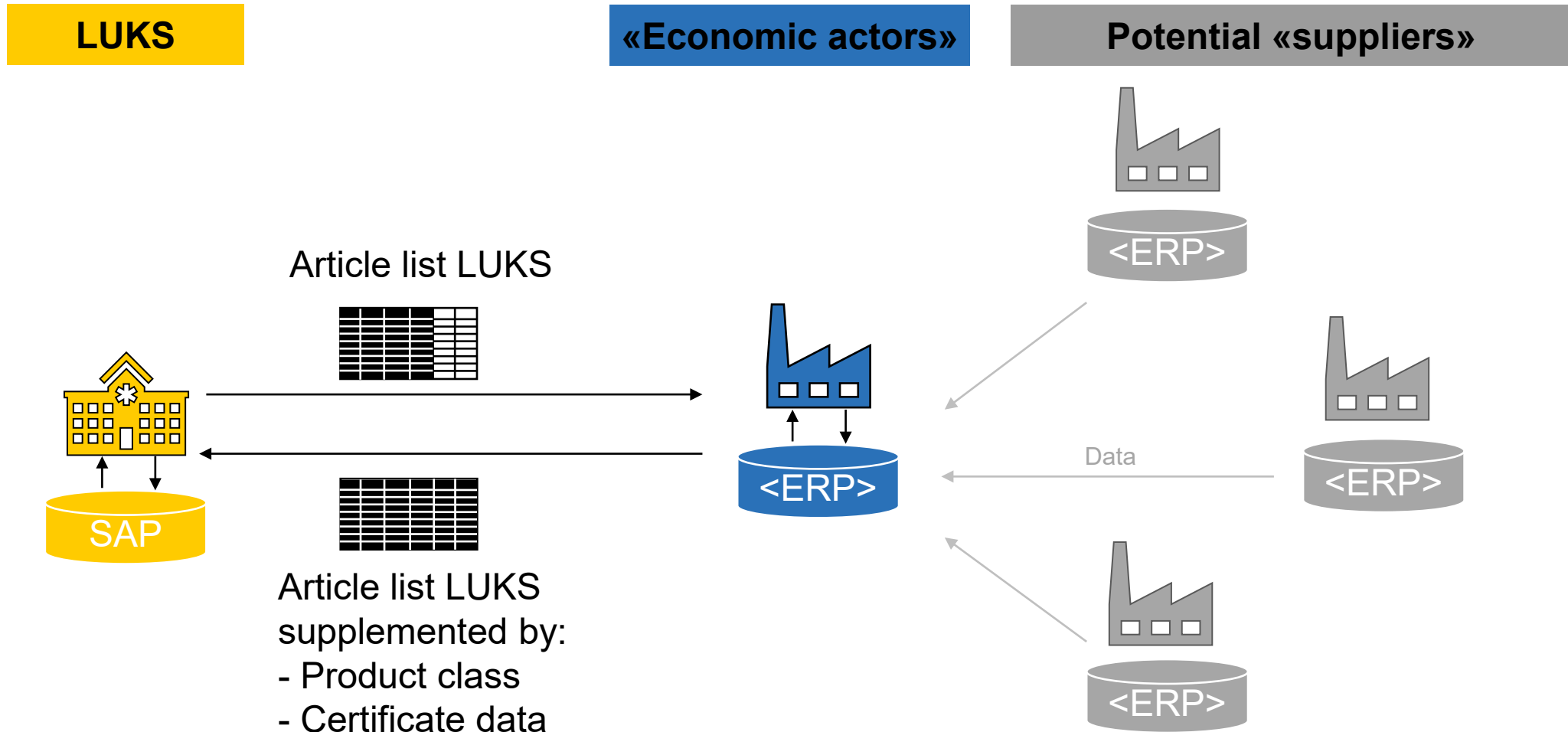

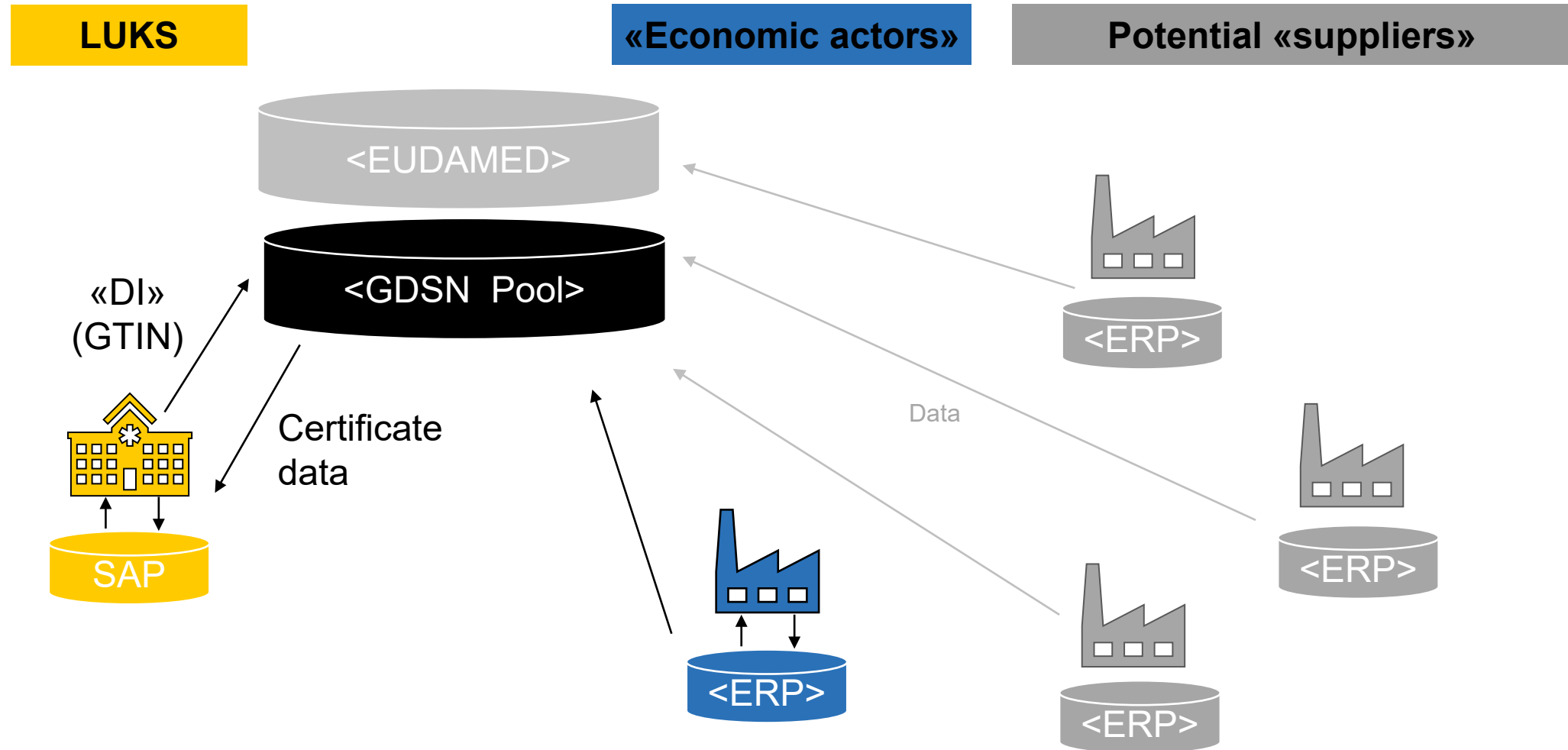

SNAP MDR Tool – one «central database»



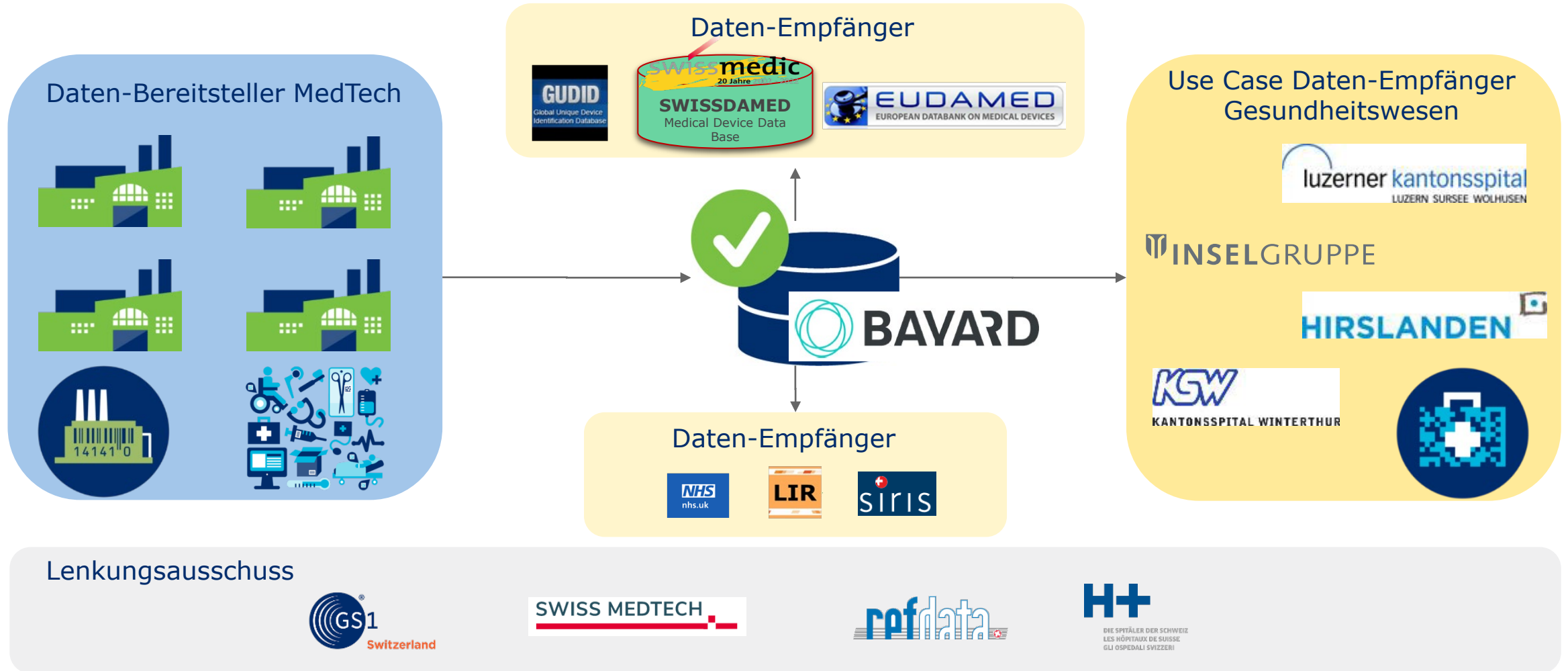
Connection to central database» – dreams of the future?

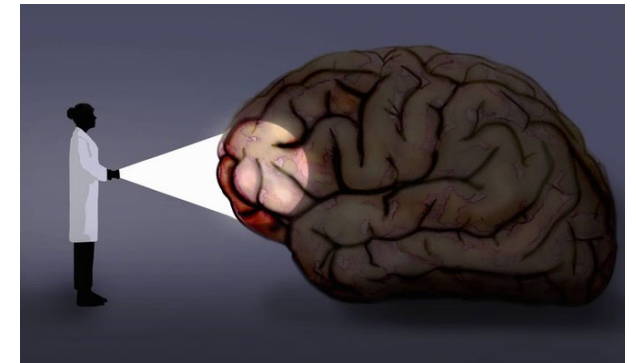

Partnerships with suppliers are essential

MDR requires end-to-end systems/ knowledge more than ever – the gap is huge

- we expect knowledge & data on the current MDD/ MDR situation
- Contemporary IT systems
 - Interconnected systems
 - Master data that also deserve the name
 - EDI (GS1 Standards)
- Communication
 - transparent – delivery dates
 - proactive – act in the event of emerging problems
 - competent – where/how is supplier positioned



Lessons learned

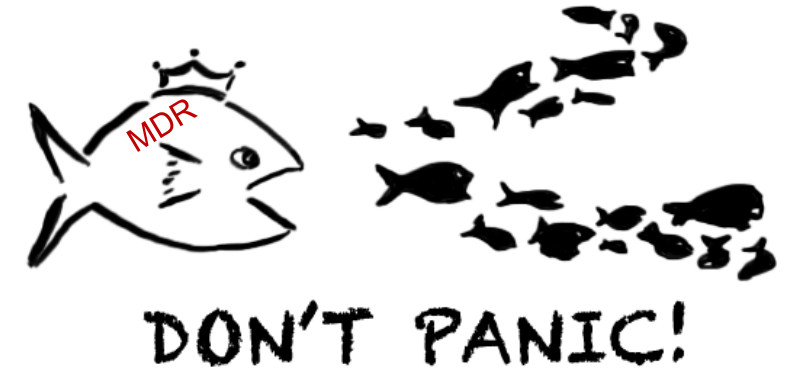
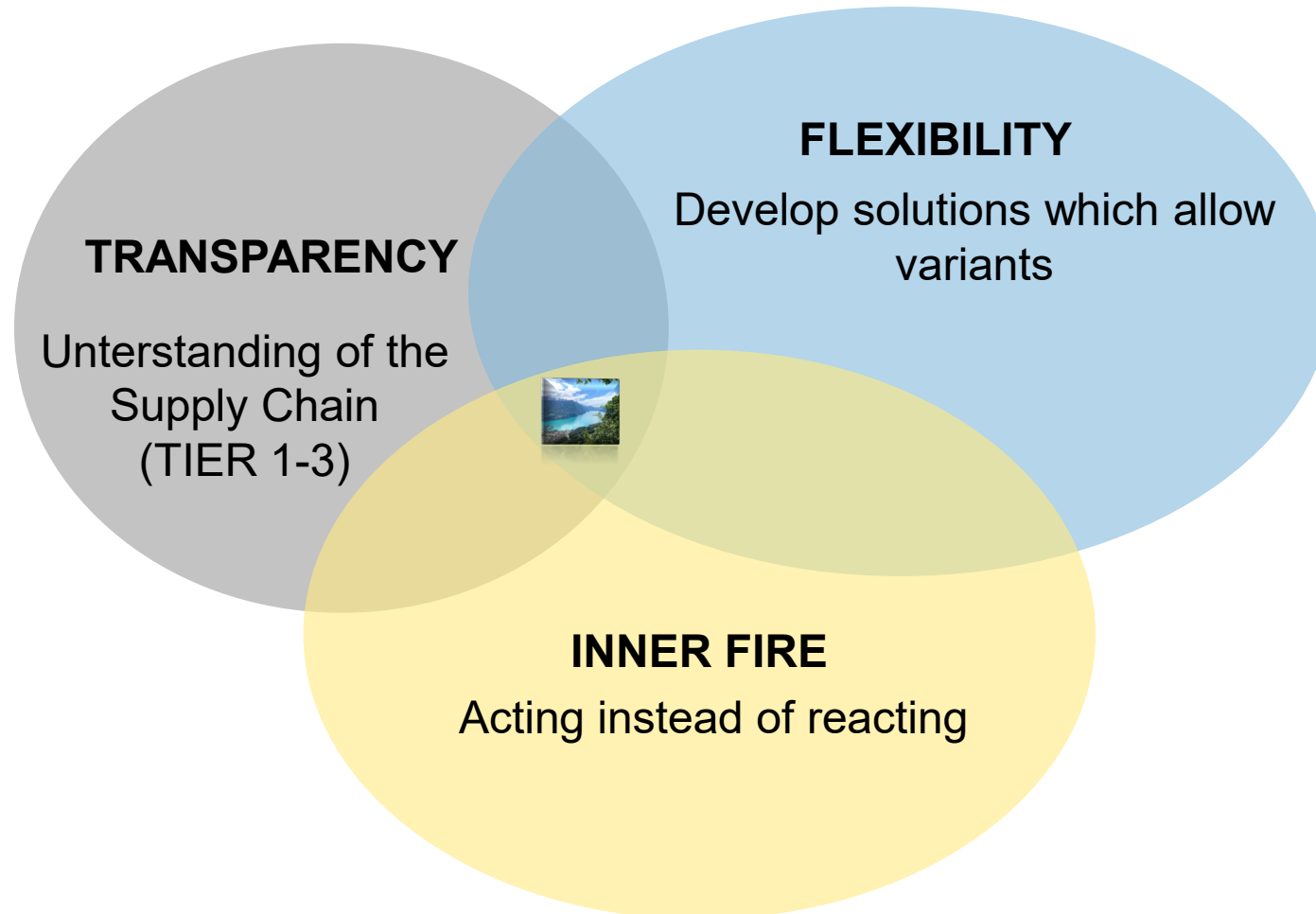
MDR as a «fire accelerant» for a long overdue step change
