

And he said, 'This is what I shall do:



GOSPEL According to LUKE

All three Readings quote from the same hymn sheet. In unison their song is, Greed is Bad. The laws of the land are meant to advance the common good, to regulate how we conduct our daily dealings with one another in the interests of justice and fairness, and to keep and protect the general public from wrongdoing. It's a big task. Ever since Cain killed his brother Abel, our human nature has been wounded. The wound has festered and proliferated, contaminating the waters of humane living. Chief among the toxins is greed.


For survival, a baby is greedy for milk from one source or another. One part of parenting is to broaden the toddler's diet to include solids. A second key task is to wean the child off greediness-s/he can't have all the toys all the time-and teach him/her to share. But the tug-of-war between greed and generosity goes on all our days. When grabbing outmuscles giving then trust goes out the door. When much wants more then we lose balance and fall, causing harm. Sometimes injured parties choose to suffer in silence. Other times, summonses replace invitations. Kitchens are exchanged for courtrooms. Offices may give way to cells.

Sooner or later an appointment is made for each one of us with an undertaker. We will have no say in it. We will travel light, for, as wise ones will have told us, a shroud has no pockets. All we will need to have put away is enough to bury or cremate us. All else will be left behind, surplus to requirement. All we will carry with us is our name, offering it for inscription in the 'book of life'. But someone else will decide on that. That someone will ask each of us the very same set of questions: Did you love? Did you give? Did you forgive? Did you let me love you? Did you let me love your neighbor?

Seeing your Life through the Lens of the Gospel

- 1. 'One's life does not consist in the abundance of possessions', said Jesus. What have you found by experience to be more important in life than possessions? What brought this home to you?
- 2. 'Be on your guard against all kinds of greed'. Perhaps you have seen how greed can lead to trouble in public life, in family life, and in the personal life of individuals. What has helped you to guard against greed? What benefits have you experienced when you were less greedy?
- 3. The message of the parable could be summed up in saying 'if you want to give God a laugh, tell him your plans '. Life takes many twists and turns we do not anticipate. When have you found that you had to change your plans because of unexpected circumstances? What has helped you to be flexible and resourceful at such times?



Holy Ghost Feast Origin and Tradition



The Portuguese Feast of the Holy Ghost is a tradition of adoration to the third person of the Blessed Trinity. The feast and its traditions were modeled after the example set by Queen Isabella (or Elizabeth) of Portugal (1271-1336).

Queen Isabella, who was canonized in 1626, was devoted to the Holy Spirit and works of charity to the poor and sick. Portuguese folklore indicates that the Queen would carry food out of the castle under her cloak. Her husband, King Denis, asked to see what she carried under her cloak. As she removed the bread, it had miraculously turned into a bouquet of roses and she was never again questioned.

She would give the poor "pensaos" which consisted of meat, bread, and wine which they took home to their families. During her reign, she would serve meals to the poor on the feast of the Trinity and "crown" a subject to demonstrate that they were equal in God's eyes. The individual honored was known as the "imperador" and later as the "mordomo".

The insignia of the Holy Spirit the dove was prominently

The insignia of the Holy Spirit, the dove, was prominently displayed on the Queen's royal trappings - her crown, banner and scepter. Facsimiles of these articles are still used in the religious traditions of the Feast and are displayed on the altar when they are not in use during the eight weeks prior to the Feast.

Two colors are used in conjunction with the feast: red and white. Red symbolizes the tongues of fire, the form in which the Holy Spirit descended on the Apostles, and white symbolizes peace, purity and divinity. The seven gifts of the Holy Spirit are symbolized by our seven weeks (domingas) of adoration from Easter Sunday through Pentecost Sunday.

The Crown, symbolizing the Holy Spirit, is delivered to each "dominga" family for one week beginning on Easter Sunday. During each families week of hosting the Holy Spirit, their home is open to the public and at 8:00 PM the rosary is recited in front of their altar. Following the recitation of the rosary, the traditional Portuguese sweetbread (massa), wine, and other refreshments are served.

At the completion of each week, the dominga family returns to 10:00 mass in a cortege. Immediately following mass, the cortege forms on the altar for the "crowning" ceremony. After mass, the cortege travels to the next dominga home and presents the family with the crown, beginning their week. The eighth and final dominga of the year is at the Mordomo's home from Sunday through Friday evening. The two days of the feast are the highlight of this beautiful tradition. On Saturday, the eve of Trinity Sunday, the crown is moved to the Holy Ghost Hall (Fenner Avenue). On that evening a roast beef dinner is served prior to recitation of the rosary and musical entertainment ends the evening. On Trinity Sunday all the dominga families process from Holy Ghost Hall to church for the final crowning of the year at 10:00 mass. After mass, all eight corteges, joined by bands and invited guests, march in procession back to Holy Ghost Hall. Traditional "sopas" (Portuguese soup) and roast beef are served to all attending in like manner to Saint Isabella serving her subjects. he entire Feast day is filled with devotion and unity. The Feast celebration officially ends after selection of the seven dominga names and the announcement of the new Mordomo.

The messages attributed to Our Lady of Medjugorje have a strong following among Catholics worldwide. Medjugorje has become one of the most popular pilgrimage sites for Catholics in the world and has turned into Europe's third most important apparition site, where each year more than 1 million people visit. It has been estimated that 30 million pilgrims have come to Međugorje since the reputed apparitions began in 1981.

In one of her first messages, Our Lady gave us a present of the Five Stones of Medjugorje:



- praying the Rosary with our heart every day
- 2. fasting twice every week
- 3. visiting the Holy Confession every month
- 4. receiving the Eucharist every Sunday
- 5. reading the Bible every day
