







































read me:

- 1. Print "bingo cards back no words"
- 2. Turn the pages over and print "bingo cards front with Lao and English words" on the other side. (make sure the pages are in the right order so you have the same words on each side)
- 3. There are 2 player cards per page. Cut them apart.
- 4. Print another copy of "bingo cards front with Lao and English words" and cut apart the 9 picture cards on each page. These will be the calling cards for the teacher/leader to use in the game.
- 5. The teacher or leader chooses a picture calling card and reads the word. Whoever says "I have it" gets the picture calling card to cover the space on their card. For beginners use the side of the player cards with the words written in Lao and English. Once they should know the vocabulary use the side with no words.
- 5. There are 10 bingo player cards. For more students let them play in groups or print more cards. If you print more than one copy of each player card whoever says "I have it" first gets the picture calling card to cover the space on their player card.
- 6. The winner is the student/group who covers all of the picture words on their player card first or with more than one copy of the same player card, whoever has the card with the most spaces covered when all the picture calling cards are used.
