An Ordinance to levy and assess a tax for Bethalto Public Library District of the county of Madison, state of Illinois for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2022 and ending June 30, 2023

BE IT ORDAINED, that the Bethalto Public Library District of the County of Madison and State of Illinois shall levy a tax of .02% of the value of all taxable property within said District, for building and maintenance purposes, subject to the right of the electors in said District to petition and require an election concerning the imposition of such tax, pursuant to 75 ILCS 16/35-5.

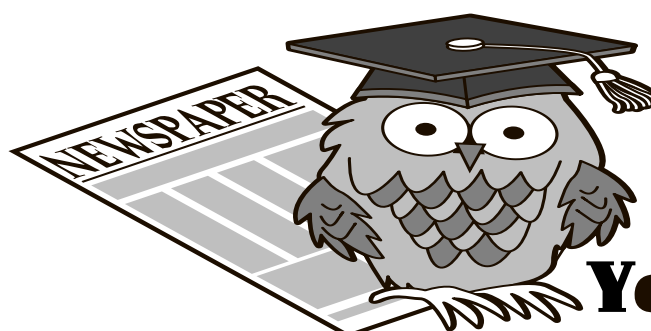

Even though this happened many years ago, I just can't believe my mom is still married to this man. But we just can't be in his company any longer.

We went over for Thanksgiving a couple of years ago, but it was very

awkward. I have maybe seen him once after that in my mom's presence. The older I get, the more I can't understand how my mom can stay with him. My sister and I brought it up to her several years ago, and her false theory is that my sister made the whole thing up. I know in my heart she didn't.

My mom and I were never very close. I love my mom, but I can't respect her. My son doesn't go over to my mom's house; I don't allow it because of what happened to my sis-

ter. I'm trying to cut ties completely with my mom. I feel at fault, as I should have completely cut ties long ago. I don't know why I didn't. But as I've distanced myself more, she'll try to come over to drop things off or find another excuse to see me. I'm getting weary. I try not to be rude, but how can I give her the hint that I'm devastated that she stayed with a man who hurt my sister? It makes me sick. Thank you for reading my letter. — **Weary at Heart**

**Dear Weary at Heart:** As hard as it is, you must be assertive with your mother. Your attempt to "give her the hint," as you say, has failed, and she needs to know that you're

serious about these boundaries. If she continues to live in denial and to gaslight you and your sister, then she will no longer be a part of your family.
