



RUSHING FALL COAST TO COAST IN QE II



Rushing Fall makes it six-for-seven lifetime | Coady

Winner of the GII JP Morgan Chase Jessamine S. en route to victory in last year's GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf and the GII Applachian S. over a yielding local course on seasonal debut this past spring, eFive Racing Thoroughreds' Rushing Fall (More Than Ready) was hammered at the tills and left little in doubt in Saturday's GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup to remain perfect over the Keeneland turf course. Mission Impassible (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}), Group 1-placed in France at two and a Group 2 winner this term, was runner-up ahead of fellow European raider Nyaleti (Ire) (Arch) in third.

"The filly's phenomenal," said winning owner Bob Edwards, whose New Money Honey (Medaglia d'Oro) was well-beaten as the favorite last year. "We've had an unbelievable run with her. Super happy to be here at Keeneland."

Both GI Del Mar Oaks heroine **Fatale Bere (Fr)** (Pedro the Great) and GIII Pucker Up S. victrix **Secret Message** (Hat Trick {Jpn}) were fractious pre-start, but the former hit the ground running once the gates flew and led for a few strides, but Javier Castellano gave Rushing Fall a dig from the outside stall and the duo gradually worked their way down to the inside and ultimately to the front passing under the wire with a circuit to travel.

TORONTO SIMCOCK'S SECOND HOME

When trainer David Simcock decides to send one or more of his runners based at Trillium Place in Newmarket to Canada, it usually pays to pay attention.

In 2014, the conditioner launched not one, but two successful raids on Woodbine, winning the GI Northern Dancer S. with his likable stayer Sheikhzayedroad (GB) (Dubawi {Ire}) and the GI Ricoh Woodbine Mile on the same program with the reliable Trade Storm (GB) (Trade Fair {GB}). Some five weeks later, Caspar Netscher (GB) (Dutch Art {GB}) continued the streak in the GII Nearctic S. Twelve months later, Sheikhzayedroad ran home gamely to be third in the GI Pattison Canadian International, and **Desert Encounter (Ire)** (Halling) was the stable's choice to fly the flag in the 12-furlong feature Saturday afternoon. The results were predictable, even as the tote read 8-1 on the 6-year-old gelding.

The first was quarter up in :23.91, and having not expended a great deal of energy, Rushing Fall galloped them along down the back and the pace slackened further still, with the half a moderate :49.22 and three-quarters in a pedestrial and very manageable 1:14.82. Nyaleti tried to go on the attack from her ground-saving position and Mission Impassible was making some progress while enduring a wider passage, but Castellano was still swinging off the chalk as heads were turned from home. Despite sacrificing some ground loss on the bend, Mission Impassible drew more or less on even terms a furlong and a half from home, but Rushing Fall stiff-armed that challenge and tossed in a final furlong in :11.49 to hold firm to the wire.

Unbeaten in three runs at two, including a second straight score for eFive in the Juvenile Fillies Turf (New Money Honey, 2016), the bay resumed with a one-length tally in the Appalachian before getting tagged on the wire to suffer her first defeat in the GIII Edgewood S. at Churchill May 4. She had one subsequent appearance, a 2 3/4-length defeat of **Capla Temptress (Ire)** (Lope de Vega {Ire}) in Saratoga's GII Lake Placid S. Aug. 18.

Rushing Fall is one of 23 worldwide Grade I/Group 1 winners for her sire, who is also responsible for GI Belmont Derby and GI Travers S. hero Catholic Boy, also a product of the Hertrich/ Fielding breeding operation. In addition to the stakes performers listed below, she is also kin to Homecoming Dance (Vindication), the dam of 2018 Damon Runyon S. winner Empire Line (Morning Line). Rushing Fall's year-younger half-sister is named Queen Eli (Candy Ride {Arg}) and was purchased by bloodstock agent Liz Crow for \$210,000 out of the 2017 Keeneland September sale. The 16-year-old Autumnal has not produced a live foal since.



With Andrea Atzeni in for the ride, Desert Encounter missed the kick by a good two lengths, but that allowed his rider to cut right down to the inner running rail to save ground as GI United Nations S. winner Funtastic (More Than Ready) led from Tiz a Slam (Tiznow) and a three-deep Bandua (The Factor). The latter --third in the GI Secretariat S., but only fourth as the favorite in the Dueling Grounds Derby last time--went forward to take up the running exiting the hairpin first turn and tried to slow the pace down as positions remained largely unchanged behind. Patiently ridden on the back of favored Thundering Blue (Exchange Rate) down the backstretch and onto the final turn, Desert Encounter looked to be traveling well and full of run as Bandua took them into the straight. Switched off heels, Desert Encounter found clear sailing several paths off the inside, but Thundering Blue was also hitting his best stride and struck to the front with a furlong to travel. The lead was short-lived, however, as Desert Encounter rolled up to join the battle while drifting in a bit at the sixteenth pole, then was straightened away to score convincingly. Focus Group (Kitten's Joy) made decent progress from last to finish clearly third.

"David Simcock has been here on a few occasions," Phillip Robinson, racing manager to owner Abdulla Al Mansoori explained. "He loves it. I think he's had this race in mind for a long time for this horse. He said that this is the race for him. And he set out his program throughout the whole season to [prepare] him to come here. It worked out. He got it dead right."

Beaten only 4 1/2 lengths into third by the classy Poet's Word (Ire) (Poet's Voice {GB}) in the G3 Brigadier Gerard S. at Sandown in May, Desert Encounter was beaten a pole to that rival when sixth in the G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot in July. He was snapping a six-race skid when landing the Listed August S. at Windsor Aug. 25 and was exiting a close third in the G3 Legacy Cup at Newbury Sept. 22.

Desert Encounter was purchased in utero by Tally-Ho Stud for 48,000gns (about \$81,000) from Darley at the 2011 Tattersalls July Sale and is out of a full-sister to GSW Allied Powers (Ire) and a half-sister to Italian GSW & G1SP Dane Friendly (GB) (Danehill). These same connections campaign Desert Encounter's 2-year-old half-brother Desert Land (Ire) (Kodiac {GB}), a 150,000gns acquisition out of the 2017 Tattersalls October sale and a debut fourth at Yarmouth Sept. 19. La Chicana is the dam of a yearling filly by Slade Power (Ire) and a weanling filly by Vadamos (Fr).



European invader Sheikha Reika made her debut at the graded level in style with a late-surging success in the GI E.P. Taylor S. at Woodbine Saturday. Squeezed a bit at the break, the 550,000gns TATOCT buy did not let it impede her momentum and settled in fourth, running in the two-path as Starship Jubilee (Indy Wind) walked the dog on the front end through opening splits of :26.77 and :52.68. Three-wide turning for home, the 3-year-old found another gear in mid-stretch with the help of several left-handed reminders from her pilot Andrea Atzeni, powering to the front in the final strides to best fellow European Golden Legend, who was mirroring Sheikha Reika's late rally to her outside.

"It was very important for her to jump out well...it was very important for me to take a good position heading into the first corner and travel nicely," said Atzeni, who also piloted GI Pattison Canadian International S. victor Desert Encounter (Ire) (Halling). "The pace was a bit slow, but it turned into a little bit of a sprint, that's why she sort of took her time to hit top gear, but when she hit top gear, she went on to win in the end."

He added, "She is a big mare and the ground is probably slow-a little bit 'dead' for her. She's a better filly over fast ground, but she got the job done today, which is the main thing."

"I think she would've won a bit more comfortable if the race had gone a bit faster," said assistant trainer Michael McGowan. "The ground was a bit loose, which doesn't suit her--she likes fast ground, so I was a bit worried because the leaders went slow enough to stay where they were. The last 50 yards, she really picked up and took off."

After playing bridesmaid in her first three attempts, Sheikha Reika graduated at fourth asking at Newmarket Apr. 19. Fourth next out at Ascot Sept. 8, she captured the John Musker S. by 4 1/2 lengths at Yarmouth Sept. 19.

Haltered for \$50,000 by one of the shrewdest claiming trainers in recent memory, Hembree stayed on best of all in the long run home at Woodbine and was shoved across the line narrowly best to take Saturday's GII Nearctic S. at Woodbine.

Well away from gate four, the dark bay drifted back and settled slightly worse than midfield as the quick-starting favorite Lady Alexandra (More Than Ready) ceded the lead to the busily ridden Yorkton underneath her about a sixteenth of a mile into the proceedings.

Quietly ridden on the sweeping turn while slowly creeping into it, Hembree was switched out at the quarter pole, but still had work to do, as Yorkton was still going great guns up front. Put to a left-handed stick by Irad Ortiz, Jr., the colt stuck on gamely down the outside and was along in the last jump. Yorkton just held for second ahead of the rail-rallying Hemp Hemp Hurray.

Claimed away from Maker and Ken and Sarah Ramsey for \$50,000 last summer, Hembree rejoined the barn following a third-place effort in a seven-furlong event over the Aqueduct main track this past April. Third in a rained-off Belmont allowance May 27, he was the easy winner of a one-mile allowance on the Belmont lawn June 16 and finished fourth over that trip at the Spa Sept. 1 before annexing a Kentucky Downs allowance going seven panels 12 days later.

MONOMOY GIRL, THUNDER SNOW WORK **TOWARDS BC AT CHURCHILL**

Tuning up for their appearance in respective Breeders' Cup races at Churchill Downs Nov. 3, leading 3-year-old filly Monomoy Girl (Tapizar) and G1 Dubai World Cup winner Thunder Snow (Ire) (Helmet {Aus}) registered dramatically different five-furlong breezes beneath the Twin Spires Saturday morning.

Monomoy Girl, the GI Kentucky Oaks winner and leading candidate for the sophomore filly Eclipse Award, came out onto the track at about 7:30 a.m. and earned the bullet for her fiveeighths drill that was clocked in 1:00 flat (video) with regular rider Florent Geroux in the irons. It was the fastest of 46 works at the distance and was accomplished in fractions of :24.40 and :36.60 before galloping out six furlongs in 1:13 flat. Also victorious in the GI Ashland S., the GI Acorn S. and GI CCA Oaks, Monomov Girl crossed the wire first in the GI Cotillion S. in her most recent trip to the races, but was disqualified and placed second for causing interference to Midnight Bisou (Midnight Lute). Monomoy Girl is set to face older rivals for the first time in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff.

Led out to the track around 9 a.m., GI Breeders' Cup Classic hopeful Thunder Snow was working for the first time since his game runner-up effort in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup and lobbed around through an opening four furlongs in :52 2/5

before being finishing his final furlong in a solid :12 1/5 for a composite time of 1:04 3/5 (43/46) (video). He galloped out three-quarters of a mile with good energy in 1:17 1/5 and was up seven furlongs in 1:31 1/5.

GUNNEVERA WORKS IN COMPANY FOR CLASSIC

Multiple graded stakes winner and multi-millionaire Gunnevera (Dialed In), who figures to be one of the main threats in the \$6-million GI Breeders' Cup Classic Nov. 3 at Churchill Downs, put in a strong work for the upcoming 1 1/4-mile event. Breezing in company with his stakes-placed stablemate, the 3-year-old Cometin (Trappe Shot) at Gulfstream Park West, the 4-year-old covered five furlongs in 1:00.82 with regular race rider Edgard Zayas aboard. The work was the second fastest of 26 at the distance.

"He did it very easy," said trainer Antonio Sano. "I needed the horse to have a more intense work today and get him stronger for the race. I wanted to wake him up a little bit. The work was very good and he is very happy."

Gunnevera's prior breeze was a more leisurely five-eighths in 1:02.

Gunnevera is scheduled to have two more works at Gulfstream Park West before heading to Kentucky to make final preparations for the Classic. After finishing in a dead-heat for fifth in the 2017 Classic with champion Arrogate (Unbridled's Song), Gunnevera began this year with a third behind reigning Horse of the Year Gun Runner (Candy Ride (Arg)) in the GI Pegasus World Cup Invitational S. He then sustained a foot injury while finishing off the board in the Mar. 31 G1 Dubai World Cup and took several months off to recover before coming back to romp in an allowance Aug. 10 at Gulfstream Park. The Margoth colorbearer was last seen finishing second behind Yoshida (Jpn) (Heart's Cry {Jpn}), who also heads to the Classic, in the Sept. 1 Gl Woodward S. at Saratoga.





TOO HOT, TOO QUICK, TOO GOOD



Too Darn Hot rolls in the Dewhurst | Racing Post

Fears in the Lloyd-Webber-Gosden camp that the unseasonable balmy temperature would undermine Too Darn Hot (GB) (Dubawi {Ire}) grew with every increase in fahrenheit ahead of Saturday's G1 Darley Dewhurst S., but the sensational 'TDN Rising Star' duly proved impervious to any obstacle to achieving juvenile champion status. With Newmarket basking in the weird heat, it was expected that the dynamism that had marked his wins on rain-eased ground in the Sept. 1 G3 Solario S. and Sept. 15 G2 Champagne S. would be dumbed down in the strongest encounter of his brief career. For a period of a furlong or so as the track's most extreme undulations came into play, the even-money favourite did look in bother, but Frankie Dettori kept looking for momentum to power out of the "dip". The homebred responded with a surge to record an ultimately emphatic 2 3/4-length defeat of Advertise (GB) (Showcasing {GB}), with Anthony Van Dyck (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) 1 1/4 lengths away in third. Dettori, who like trainer John Gosden was winning this prestige event for the first time, was left in no doubt as to the winner's merit.

"He's an amazing horse and among the best I've ridden," he said. "He's got everything, a good cruising speed and really quickens. He's got pace and is bred to stay."

HAVANA GREY TO WHITSBURY MANOR

Last month's G1 Flying Five S. winner **Havana Grey (Ire)** (Havana Gold {GB}–Blanc De Chine {Ire}, by Dark Angel {Ire}) will enter stud next year at Whitsbury Manor Stud.

Whitsbury Manor Director Ed Harper said of the 3-year-old, "We've been following him ever since he won the [G3] Molecomb [S.] as a 2-year-old as he's such a strong individual with a big sales walk. After his Group 1 and Group 2 wins this summer, it was just a matter of whether we could afford him."

"He's the fastest horse from the Galileo sire line, and combining that with his dam by Dark Angel, it makes him a very exciting sire to send fast, commercial mares. It is possible he may run once more in the [GI] Breeders Cup Turf Sprint, but we'll aim to start showing him to breeders in mid-November."

"A select number of lifetime breeding rights will be sold in a similar way to how we have managed Showcasing."

Dettori continued, "He's had three easy races in his life and he was getting knocked about in the middle and ran in snatches, so for a minute I thought I would struggle. Then the turbo kicks in and on he goes--in the end I was able to ease him down."

If things had appeared to come easy to Too Darn Hot since his introduction at Sandown just over two months ago, it is only due to his inherent ability as he had a difficult trip to overcome in the Solario and in the Champagne.

He could easily have led from the outset in any of his outings and that was the case again here but Dettori was exercising the usual heavy restraint as he tucked the bay in behind the Ballydoyle-carved tempo.

Stuck in a pocket until the ruthless pace began to draw out the field, he was flat-footed when asked to put in a major effort running downhill and was not making the customary smooth progress as Advertise and Anthony Van Dyck pressed on in front.

As soon as he became balanced, there was the same overwhelming finale on display and he was really going somewhere at the line to leave proven Group 1 performers behind and put 8 1/2 lengths between him and the talented duo Sangarius (GB) (Kingman {GB}) and Kuwait Currency (Kitten's Joy).

"They've gone a good pace but he was on the metal, so Frankie had to cover him up and he did that beautifully," John Gosden commented. "The interesting thing was when he was brought out he was not comfortable in the dip and then got balanced and flew. It is firm and he needs good ground, but that's his class showing. Seven is sharp enough for him, but he's blessed with an awful lot of speed and he seems to be taking more after his father. He's a great guy and a wonderful character--he's with you 100%. It has to be the 2000 Guineas now. It's a little unusual to go Group 3, Group 2 and Group 1, but he's shown his class and this is a bit of a dream come true for Madeleine and Andrew."

Gosden also has Calyx (GB) (Kingman {GB}), who has been absent since beating Advertise arguably as impressively as Too Darn Hot did here back in June at Royal Ascot. The proximity of the runner-up was not lost on the Clarehaven maestro, who added, "They have never worked together, but Calyx is the only other one I have who compares and he is in great form at the moment--he's just trotting and playing about and he'll be back next year. It'll be wonderful if they could meet in the spring and we hope they will. I expected that first four, Advertise has run a fabulous race and Aidan's wants a mile now."

Martyn Meade was far from down-hearted despite the defeat of Advertise.

Meade said, "I'm really pleased that he got the seven furlongs-I was a little bit apprehensive about that, but he's acquitted himself brilliantly. He lost his action going into the dip and then run on again, so it was a really good performance and the Guineas is on the cards. It has always been at the back of my mind, but I had to wait until I knew he'd get a mile so I'll train him for that now."

Pedigree Notes...

Dar Re Mi (GB) (Singspiel {Ire}), who got the Lloyd-Webbers' bandwagon rolling as she emerged as a high-class performer 10 years ago, had already been front and centre this week with her yearling full-brother to Too Darn Hot selling for 3.5 million gns at Tattersalls. The winner had been due to go there 12 months ago, but for once luck was on the side of his owner-breeders as what was perceived as an unfortunate setback at the time turned out to be one of those welcome twists of fate. Dar Re Mi was as strong a middle-distance stayer as her pedigree suggested she would be, but her daughters also by Dubawi, So Mi Dar (GB) and Lah Ti Dar (GB), have proven contrasting types. The former had genuine 10-furlong speed and probably would have been stretched going further, while the latter was staying on to great effect at the end of the extended 14-furlong trip of last month's G1 St Leger. Both were denied runs in a British Classic--the Epsom Oaks in their case--due to training complications and it is up to Too Darn Hot to snap that trend back here on the first Saturday in May. He may have another Dubawi in the way there if Godolphin's Quorto (Ire) makes the engagement. Dar Re Mi's 2018 filly is again by that sire, who has come to the fore in a year where he has challenged the great Galileo with more resilience than ever. 

AUTUMN REIGN

Having to work harder than he is accustomed to at Newmarket on Saturday, Ballymore Thoroughbred's 'TDN Rising Star' Persian King (Ire) (Kingman {GB}) pulled it out nevertheless to take a strong-looking renewal of the G3 Masar Godolphin Autumn S. Successful by five lengths from fellow 'TDN Rising Star' Lone Peak (Fr) (Lope de Vega (Ire)) in a mile conditions event at Chantilly Sept. 15, the 6-5 favourite tracked the honest tempo in third against the rail going best under Pierre-Charles Boudot. Still travelling strongly passing the three-furlong marker, the bay homebred moved around Ballydoyle's Circus Maximus (Ire) (Galileo (Ire)) and to the lead approaching the furlong pole. Pressed all the way to the line by the other Rosegreen representative Magna Grecia (Ire) (Invincible Spirit {Ire}), he held off that rival to prevail by a neck, with three lengths back to Circus Maximus in third. "The race was perfect for my horse, it was a good, regular pace and he had a long turn of foot," Boudot said. "He's good and he did it well."



"He was relaxed and very easy with the undulations, so it's a good sign for the future."

Persian King, whose sole defeat so far came at the hands of Anodor (Fr) (Anodin {Ire}) when second to that subsequent G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere third on debut at Deauville Aug. 7, was also successful by six lengths on his second outing also at Chantilly a fortnight before his tour de force last time. With Karl Burke taking out Phoenix Thoroughbred Limited's promising Kadar (Scat Daddy), his task was made lighter but the presence of Ballydoyle's impressive Sept. 30 Naas seven-furlong maiden scorer Magna Grecia puts the form in a good light. Anthony Stroud, representing Ballymore, said, "The jockey said he really handled the ground well and he seemed to stay very well. It was a tougher race than one envisaged, but he showed a lot of courage in winning. This is the first time he's had to battle and it's Andre Fabre's call if he is a Guineas horse. I think he might go down the same path as Intello, who he brought here [for the nine-furlong Listed Feilden S. in 2013]. I see him stepping up in distance to a mile and a quarter or a mile and a half, but that is completely Andre Fabre's call."

Aidan O'Brien said of the second and third, "We are delighted with them. Magna Grecia won nicely 13 days ago and we had no problem running him again. The other one [Circus Maximus] is still a baby. I think it was an honest race, with an even pace."

"We will see how they are. They could run again, but they don't have to."

The winner, who is the second group and fifth black-type winner for his freshman sire in 2018, is the second foal out of Pretty Please (Ire) (Dylan Thomas (Ire)), who is herself a three-parts sister to the G1 Prix Ganay hero and sire Planteur (Ire) (Danehill Dancer (Ire)) and a half to the dual listed winner Pilote d'Essai (GB) (Oasis Dream {GB}). The bay stalked the pace trapped wide in third after an alert break from the outside gate in this third-straight try at the sixfurlong trip. Looming large soon after passing halfway, the 32-5 chance went to the front at the two pole and kept on strongly under a late drive once claiming the stands' side rail entering the final eighth to assert by 2 1/2 lengths from fellow British raider Queen of Bermuda (Ire) (Exceed and Excel (Aus)). Graignes (Fr) (Zoffany {Ire}) was the lone domestic contender in the eightrunner field and ran on well in the closing stages to finish a halflength adrift in third. "We came over here in search of softer ground and that's exactly what we got," said winning rider Kevin Stott. "Of course, it was a big step up from his latest run at Haydock to a Group 2 race, but he's a big, strong colt with plenty of quality and it helps that there seems to be fewer runners to face in these French group races. He's still green, and a bit babyish, and he lacks experience which explains the drift to the rail in the closing stages. I really look forward to riding him next year as I think he is very good."

Second to the equally mercurial but also highly able Monarchs Glen (GB) (Frankel {GB}) sporting first-time blinkers when 33-1 in Royal Ascot's Listed Wolferton S. over 10 furlongs June 19, Euginio had them removed as his form tailed off again and responded by winning a Doncaster conditions event over that trip Sept. 12. Fifth in a decent renewal of the 11-furlong G3 Dubai Duty Free Legacy Cup at Newbury 10 days later, he was rebounding here under perfect riding tactics in a race that initially looked to lack quality and also fell apart in the running.



Front and centre after a slick departure, he had all rivals toiling at the quarter-mile marker and powered further clear under urging to easily embellish his black-type resume. "The [high] draw was hopeless [at Redcar] last week as he came in dry and never did a stroke," explained trainer Tim Easterby. "I'm delighted for the owners because they paid a lot of money for this horse. First Japan (GB) and now Norway. Ballydoyle continue to redraw the map and their momentum is flowing relentlessly into the autumn, particularly with the 2-year-old brigade. Carrying on where stablemate Kew Gardens (Ire) (Galileo (Ire)) left off 12 months ago, the chestnut was firmly on top at the end of this event which had listed status, lost it and then regained it again. Introduced in the same seven-furlong Curragh maiden as the yard's Mount Everest (Ire) (Galileo (Ire)) and Anthony Van Dyck (Ire) (Galileo (Ire)) at the start of July, Norway upstaged that pair of distinguished colts when fifth before running third behind Sydney Opera House (GB) (Australia {GB}) over a mile back there two months later. Leaping forward next time when off the mark by 6 1/2 lengths over the latter trip at Naas Oct. 2, he was travelling clear best throughout this race but was always on heels as Seamie Heffernan waited patiently behind Donnacha's pick and the well-back 11-8 favourite Sydney Opera House.

Switched around rivals and delivered on the lead with 150 yards remaining, the full-brother to the Derby hero Ruler of the World (Ire) and half to the legendary Duke of Marmalade (Ire) (Danehill) stayed on powerfully to deny the game pair of I'll Have Another and Nate the Great. "Our 2-year-olds are probably going to finish the season off real strong, as they weren't as fit as we wanted them to be for the middle part," Heffernan said. "Aidan knows how to make these well-bred horses good." The trainer added, "He is a lovely big horse, he stays well and the last day he won well and galloped to the line. It is possible that he could go to France for the [Oct. 27 G1] Criterium de Saint-Cloud, but he doesn't have to go there as he has had that experience coming here."

Norway is the last known foal out of the G3 Killavullan S. third Love Me True (Kingmambo), whose six stakes horses include the aforementioned Ruler of the World, who enjoyed his first stakes winner at this track on Friday as Iridessa (Ire) took the G1 Fillies' Mile. The five-times Group 1-winning sire Duke of Marmalade was her chief performer, while she also had the G2 Adelaide Cup winner Annus Mirabilis (Ire) (Montjeu (Ire)). The second dam Lassie's Lady (Alydar) is also the dam of the GII Sanford S. scorer Bite the Bullet (Spectacular Bid) and is the ancestress of the GI Metropolitan H. hero Bee Jersey (Jersey Town). The third dam is the outstanding producer Lassie Dear (Buckpasser), whose progeny includes the G1 Haydock Sprint Cup and G1 Prix de la Foret victor Wolfhound (Nureyev) and the high-class Weekend Surprise (Secretariat), whose own offspring includes the Classic-winning champion sires A.P. Indy (Seattle Slew) and Summer Squall (Storm Bird).



RED'S REMARKABLE EVEREST DOUBLE

A month ago, Peter Snowden and the connections of Redzel (Snitzel) were wondering if their hopes of winning Australia's richest race again had been dashed by a freak accident.

Snowden, who trains with his son, Paul, has seen most things in his long career in racing. But when Redzel emerged from his box on the morning of The Shorts sore and sorry after getting cast in his box, another summit of the famous race seemed a long way away.

"What happened in the last month has just been incredible. I wanted to run the horse that day and for some unknown reason he got cast in his box," Snowden said after Redzel's win on Saturday. "In two and half years, he's never done it before, he chose the night before a race to be cast and be sore. I thought I'm in trouble now, because it has mucked up the whole preparation I had in my mind for him."

It was a similar sinking feeling for managing owner Michael Ward of Triple Crown Syndications.

"The heart did flutter a bit when I got that phone call on the Saturday morning of The Shorts," Ward said. "But when you've got Grand Final trainers like Peter and Paul; they are magical."

Even two weeks ago Snowden's faith was again tested when Redzel returned in the G2 Premiere, where he finished fifth.

"I was disappointed on the day, but I could see in his performance it wasn't a bad run. And the last two weeks have been perfect," he said.

But as many of Redzel's major rivals lamented the falling rain this week, Snowden knew things were finally falling in his favour.

"We wanted rain and there has just been rain coming all week. And everything has just fallen into place today, and I just can't believe it," he said.

As far as \$13-million races go, it was as comfortable as it could get. Likely speed rival U S Navy Flag (USA) (War Front {USA}) missed the start, leaving Redzel to dictate.

"From the one gate, that was Plan A, to control it from the front," jockey Kerrin McEvoy said. "That's what this horse is able to do. He loved the ground and is such a little warrior. He is a joy to be a part of."

McEvoy never really had any concerns. Redzel put a couple of lengths on his rivals at the top of the straight and while Trapeze Artist (Snitzel) tried valiantly to close the gap, he never seriously looked a threat.

Post-race, Snowden was still trying to comprehend how straightforward the race has been.

"I just hope I don't fall out of bed and wake up," he said. "It's been a dream."

McEvoy, a two-time winner of the Melbourne Cup, was simply delighted to have written his name as the first dual winner of this race.

"This is euphoria at its best. It is such an electric feeling. I was really happy there was a bit of rain around and he did the rest. It is a huge buzz to win it again, unbelievable," he said.

Triple Crown bought Redzel for \$120,000 at Magic Millions and he has now surpassed Maybe Diva as Australasia's second biggest prizemoney winner, with \$14.8-million.

"Different weather, same result; it's an absolute dream come true," Chris Ward said. "To do this the first time was unbelievable, it was beyond our wildest dreams to do it again."

It was also a significant success for Yulong Investments and their owner Zhang Yueshang, the slot-holders who selected Redzel all the way back in May.

Yulong have invested significantly in Australia over the past five years and on Saturday got one of their biggest rewards.

"[Mr Zhang] was always keen on the horse. He is a big follower of Australian racing and he's been a big fan of Redzel. He was super keen to get him in his slot," Chris Ward said.

The logical question now is whether Redzel will be set for a third straight shot at the race.

"Why not, he's only young," Michael Ward said, "I like this race, I've taken a real shine to it."

Peter Snowden is similarly enthusiastic.

"We'll have to, I've got no choice, he's a gelding," the trainer said.

Sun Shines As Star Colt Turns On The Burn... By Paul Vettise

Earlier in the week, Arrowfield principal John Messara purchased a 50% controlling interest in The Autumn Sun (Redoute's Choice), who repaid his faith in spades with a sensational victory in Saturday's G1 Caulfield Guineas.

The Autumn Sun was caught three deep with no cover, but it mattered not and he strode clear with a degree of arrogance to pummel his rivals by a widening margin.

Messara now races the glamour colt with the Hong Kong-based Hermitage Thoroughbreds, who secured the blueblood out of Arrowfield Stud's Inglis Easter Yearling Sale draft for \$700,000 in 2017.

"You've just seen what he is capable of and I don't think he's matured yet," trainer Chris Waller said. "I've had experience with some nice colts and he's as good as they get."

In the wake of The Autumn Sun's effort, a clash with his champion barn-mate Winx (Street Cry {Ire}) was a natural question to pose to their handler.

"How can he beat Winx when he's not fully mature?" was Waller's response.

"I'll speak to the owners, Hermitage and Mr Messara. It's their call, not mine, they will have the final say."

The Autumn Sun left the gates smartly, but rider James McDonald wasn't able to get closer than three deep to the fence and with no cover.

He slipped the colt more rein into the straight and they forged relentlessly clear to win untested and McDonald high in the irons across the line with runner-up Vassilator (NZ) (Zacinto {GB}) chasing a memory.

"Good jockeys let horses be in their comfort zone and that just showed how good a colt he is," Waller said. "He never turned a hair and it was just like he was going to a barrier trial."

McDonald admitted it may not have been the prettiest of rides aboard The Autumn Sun, but he stayed calm and let the 3-year-old do the rest.

"It went pear-shaped early, but Chris said to keep him in his rhythm and he'll do the rest, he's by far the best," he said.

"He relaxes well and he's got all the right attributes to be one of the best in Australia. "I'm taking no credit, I was lucky enough to be on a superstar and he got the job done.

"He jumped well, too well, and he wanted to get on with it so I elected to sit out and he's got an explosive turn of foot. He's a very, very good horse."
