Silver Top Headframe

While the Silver Top Headframe Restoration project is almost complete, the Tonopah Historic Mining Park Foundation is still actively seeking much needed funds to pay for the restoration of the Silver Top Orehouse and Desert Queen Headframe. Please take a moment, renew your membership, and send us a **donation!** A portion of this project has been funded with the assistance of the Commission for Cultural Centers and Historic Preservation, which provided just over \$100,000. Round Mountain Gold (Kinross) has saved us at the last minute through a grant of \$40,000. Crews from Simerson first removed the mine cage elevator from the Silver Top Headframe. They then tightened all bolts and placed new ones. Next, the crew used tie down straps to ratchet the wood members together. The legs of the Headframe were then chain sawed from the blocks of cement placed there in the 1990s, and a large crane moved the Silver Top Headframe away from the shaft. Work was then done on the shaft, including placing new landings, repairing the collar and using expanding foam around the collar. A new concrete foundation was poured and the Silver Top Headframe will be placed back where it belongs, on top of the new foundation. All photos are by Russ Gartz, THMP Tour Guide.






