Takasaki University of Commerce has a long 108 year history, and is a university for the social sciences that was developed in 1906 from its parent institution, an all-girls high school that was established by Tane Sato. In conjunction with the affiliated junior college, it is a small university with the capacity for approximately 1,000 students that includes a rich student support system and a fully outfitted learning environment. With the founding principle of “autonomy and independence,” the university focuses on practical learning and offers a wide range of subjects such as commerce, economics, and business administration.

Takasaki University of Commerce—an incorporated educational institution—is composed of a university, a graduate school, a junior college, a high school, and a kindergarten. The total number of students studying at the incorporated educational corporation is roughly 2,300.

流通・マーケティングコース Distribution and Marketing Course

By learning corporate sales strategies that deliver high product satisfaction to consumers, students will develop the ability to understand consumers’ “needs,” which are formless, and learn how to develop a company.

情報・メディア・eビジネスコース Information and e-Business Course

By focusing on business and computer studies, students will pursue business possibilities on the Internet and develop the imagination and executive ability required to expand a business.

経営・経済コース Management and Economics Course

By maintaining a balance between management and economics, students will understand the know-how of social infrastructure. In addition, by learning various policies and laws related to these fields, students will develop the ability to view social movements from a management perspective.

会計・金融コース Accounting and Finance Course

By studying finance and tax, with a focus on bookkeeping and accounting, students will understand the distribution of money as well as its function, value, and management. Moreover, they will proactively take on the challenge of the national examination for certified public accountants and tax accountants as well as the bookkeeping certification.

観光まちづくりコース Tourism and Community Development Course

Whilst gaining deep insight into the nature of various subjects such as people, culture, history, food, nature, landscape, and industry, students will acquire the ability to construct and implement promotional measures that can be utilized for tourist attractions and the regeneration of towns.

About Gunma, Japan

Gunma prefecture is located in the northwest corner of the Kanto region—the central part of Japan. It is an area of immense natural beauty that is completely surrounded by mountains. As it is situated inland, there is no sea. There is heavy snowfall in the northern part of the prefecture, and the region is well known among tourists for its hot springs and winter ski resorts .

The city of Takasaki—the home of the university—is conveniently located in the southern part of Gunma prefecture, which is just 100 km from Tokyo or a 50-min journey by bullet train. Because Takasaki is so close to Tokyo, the local dialect is standard Japanese, which makes it the perfect location to learn standard Japanese.

There are many historic sites and cityscapes of historic value, and in 2015, the Tomioka Silk Mill in neighboring Tomioka was designated as a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Subjects to study Japanese

Takasaki University of Commerce offers “Japanese Conversation I” and “Japanese Conversation II,” and only international students are allowed to attend both. By taking these courses, students can study specialized subjects such as economics, management, and accounting whilst improving their level of Japanese.

In addition, there are small-group seminars that provide students with great opportunities to improve their Japanese language skills, predominantly for research, discussion, and presentations.

Takasaki University of Commerce Junior College

At the university, there is also a junior college on the same premises. Student exchange between university and junior college students is performed on a routine basis, and various activities and events such as club activities and the student council are conducted altogether. In other words, the university and the junior college are not separate entities.

At Takasaki University of Commerce, we are focused on developing certified public accountants and tax accountants who will become experts in the fields of bookkeeping and accountancy. We cooperate with current certified public accountants and strongly encourage students to progress. Because students are able to attend lectures taught by our professional teaching staff on campus, they do not need to spend time and effort commuting to other locations for learning, which is a significant advantage.

This is a program in which by aiming to pass the bookkeeping certificate examination and the tax accountant examination, students are able to enter the profession of accountancy, either as a tax accountant, certified public accountant, or teacher. We offer multiple course models so that students can study at various levels and beginners can embark on their educational path confidently. Moreover, students are able to choose their course model in line with their wishes or qualifications at which they are aiming.

Other than this program, there is a teacher-training program aimed at those aspiring to become teachers, and a graduate school for students aiming to pursue research and academia after completing their undergraduate degree.

We have established a student cafeteria, bakery, and shop, all of which provide meals that are nutritionally balanced and affordable.



Campus facilities support a comfortable student lifestyle, including a library, gymnasium, training room, and an infirmary.

Living Environment

Gunma prefecture is relatively affordable compared with Tokyo—the capital of Japan—and it is the perfect environment for studying abroad. For example, the average rent for an apartment near Takasaki University of Commerce is between 30,000 and 40,000 yen, which is almost half that in Tokyo. Takasaki University of Commerce is a 10-min train ride from Takasaki Station and ~15-min drive by car. Takasaki station is a major station where the bullet train halts, and numerous stores such as large supermarkets, grocery stores, clothing stores, and bookstores are located nearby. Thus, it is possible for students to procure most of their daily supplies.

It costs an average of 800–1,000 yen to dine out, but at the student cafeteria of Takasaki University of Commerce, they will be able to buy each meal for 300–500 yen. The student cafeteria is open on weekdays from 11:00 to 14:00.

Furthermore, there are mountains, rivers, and a rich, green landscape. Therefore, students will be able to enjoy the four seasons and various activities related to each time of year. It is a very habitable environment, where very few earthquakes occur compared with other prefectures.
