

FACT SHEET

Overview

Located in the heart of Upstate New York, the Oneida Indian Nation's Turning Stone Resort Casino offers world-class golf, gaming, entertainment, dining, spa and accommodations. Since opening in 1993, Turning Stone has evolved into a destination resort and one of the top five tourist destinations in New York State, hosting more than 4.5 million guests a year. The resort exceeds 3,400 acres.

- Features the biggest names in entertainment in an intimate setting
- Seats up to 800

- Tracy Morgan, Randy Travis, Kenny Rogers, Alice Cooper, Pat Benatar, Rick Springfield, Kathy Griffin, Lisa Lampanelli are among the acts that have played the Showroom

NIGHTLIFE & LOUNGES

LAVA Danceclub

- Opened in 2008
- Available Thursday, Friday and Saturday nights for dancing
- Sophisticated, New York-style club
- Accommodates up to 1,200
- Live entertainment (dancers, aerialists, etc.) frequently offered, including notable DJs Biz Markie, Lil' Kim, Kap Slap, Nick Cannon and more
- Warm weather outdoor cabana area with waterfall landscape

<u>The Gig</u>

- Opened in 2013
- The Gig is a neighborhood rock and roll joint, featuring local and regional bands, that perform on an intimate stage against a 20-foot wide video wall backdrop
- Designed to look like an underground cavern with rough brick walls and graffiti art throughout; features a striking speaker wall in the entry way comprised of 383 vintage speakers
- New York-style pizza, baked in The Gig's own pizza ovens, is a specialty, along with craft beers
- Accommodates up to 550
- Open Thursday through Saturday

Tin Rooster

- Opened in 2013
- Designed as a Country Americana barn, with a rustic interior that includes a mirrored saddle "disco-ball" and full size Airstream trailer
- The disco saddle at Tin Rooster has more than 10,000 hand cut crystal mirrors
- The DJ booth in Tin Rooster is an actual horse trailer from 1971 and came from Constantia, NY and is rumored to have transported Seattle Slew (1977 Triple Crown winner) to the Saratoga Raceway
- Available Wednesday-Saturday for dinner (serving BBQ, steaks and more)
- Live country music bands perform Thursday, Friday, Saturday nights
- Open for late-night music and cocktails Thursday through Saturday

<u>Turquoise Tiger</u>

- Opened in 2013
- Available Wednesday-Saturday nights for cocktails, music, gaming
- Sophisticated lounge and cocktail bar inspired by 1940s film noir, featuring signature craft cocktails
- A selection of Casino Table Games are offered in the Turquoise Tiger

<u> Atrium Bar (A Bar)</u>

- Opened in 2013
- Ultra-sleek lounge, featuring a full bar and sushi menu
- Open Wednesday through Saturday

Over/Under Sports Lounge

- Located on the gaming floor
- 10 big-screen TVs for watching the big game

- Open daily, 12pm to 2 am

GAMING

The Oneida Indian Nation's High Stakes Bingo began operations on Territory Road in Oneida in 1985.

In July 1993, Turning Stone Casino opened on an approximately 400-acre parcel on Oneida Nation Lands in Verona, NY. In 1995, Oneida Indian Nation High Stakes Bingo moved to the Turning Stone location, and slot machines were introduced at the casino that year, as well. The gaming floor was expanded in 2002 to its current configuration.

Today, Turning Stone offers more than 120,000sf of Las Vegas-style gaming space with a full slate of Table Games, a continually updated variety of slot machines, Poker and Keno

Slot Machines (2,080)

- Vegas-style slots, cash machines accept paper currency (\$1, \$5, \$10, \$20, \$50, \$100); Turning Stone had originally opened its gaming machine operations in 1995 with an account-based system, requiring guests to load funds onto debit-style cards to play; this was changed with a comprehensive conversion of the gaming floor to a new casino operating system enabling cash slots in March 2014
- Denominations ranging from 1 cent to \$25
- Popular games from leading manufacturers such as IGT, WMS, Bally, Artistocrat, Konami and MultiMedia, including:

Wheel of Fortune, Sex and the City, Hangover, True Blood, Top Dollar, Willy Wonka, Monopoly, Bally: Cash Wizard, Lantern Festival, Raging Rhino, Cash Spin, Aristocrat: Buffalo Stampede, Tarzan, Timber Wolf, and Sky Rider, as well as several variations of Video Poker, Draw Poker, Keno and more.

The Turning Stone Poker Room

- 32 tables of live poker for up to 320 players
- Four different poker variations at all limits in a card-club setting
- Tournaments and special promotions throughout the week
- Tableside food service available for players
- 12 large screen TVs circle the room offering live sports and other programs
- All tables equipped with phone chargers and complimentary Wi-Fi
- Features BravoPokerLive access, which provides real-time updates on games and tournaments, a computerized player waiting list and a convenient phone app

<u>Oneida Indian High Stakes Bingo</u>

- 1,358 seats
- Rated No. 3 in the World by 777.com and one of the Top 10 bingo halls in North America by Bingo Manager magazine
- Two main-feature sessions and a variety of monthly specials such as Double Payout Nights and Triple-Pay Weekends.
- Boogie Bingo the first Saturday of each month (blacklights with music DJ and emcee)
- Mark in the Dark Bingo the third Saturday of each month (club atmosphere with DJs, performers, special contests and theme nights)
- MP Bingo (multiplayer, multi casino progressive jackpot)
- Buddy Bonus Bingo, introduced in March 2014, allows players who register their friends, and play with them, to earn bonus cash payouts
- Pull-Tabs are also available in the Bingo Hall
