Tokyo is one of the world's major style capitals, recognized for its vibrant, progressive youth fashion culture. Part guide book, part street style photo album, *Tokyo Fashion City* highlights eight trendy Tokyo neighborhoods—each with its own unique fashion culture—to see what young Tokyoites are wearing, where they're shopping, what they're eating and drinking, and where they're hanging out.

Author Philomena Keet and photographer Yuri Manabe accompany the reader to Harajuku where high fashion rubs shoulders with hip-hop style; Shibuya, birthplace of the "gal" and stomping ground for Tokyo's most sophisticated fashionistas; hipster hangout Daikanyama; goth and geek Shinjuku and Ikebukuro; bohemian Koenji and otaku Nakano; Ginza where lunching ladies and dapper gentlemen play; the cosplay paradise of Akihabara; and the narrow lanes of East Tokyo, where everyday fashion gets a traditional touch.

Each mesmerizing chapter is full of photographs of young fashionistas, captured as they go about their daily lives. Interesting captions and insightful text provide background to the trends and tribes featured. With the inclusion of area maps and shop and café listings, *Tokyo Fashion City* is an indispensable resource for readers wishing to keep a finger on Tokyo's style pulse.

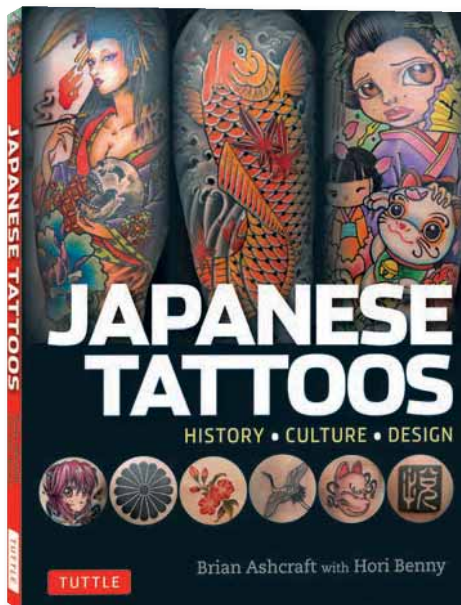

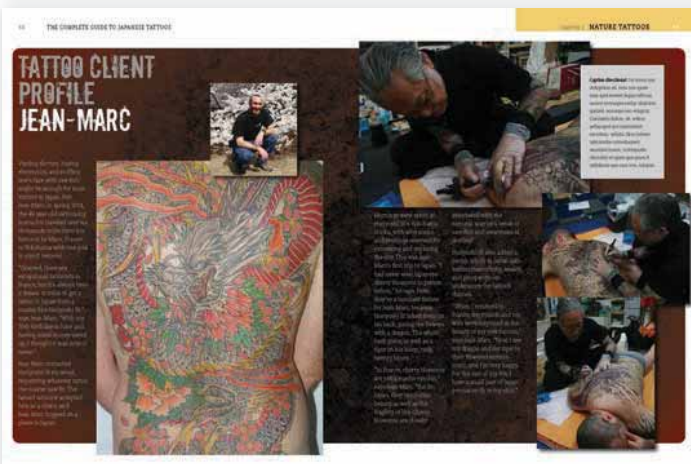
Irezumi tattoo art is an advanced Japanese art form dating back to the 17th century and the Edo period. Differing from Western tattoos, irezumi tattoos are still realized by highly-trained, traditional tattoo masters using very ancient methods. *Japanese Tattoos* offers essential information and a unique inside look at this secret, counter-cultural world.

Irezumi is rich in imagery and motifs specific to Japan. Through hundreds of color photos, and an informative and authoritative text, *Japanese Tattoos* traces the fascinating history of irezumi. This deep exploration and contextualization of technique and iconography provides a thorough understanding of the practice and culture of Japanese tattooing. The striking tattoos highlighted in this publication range from traditional tebori (hand-poked) and kanji tattoos to anime-inspired and modern works, and everything in between.

The first book of its kind, *Japanese Tattoos* features interviews with leading Japanese tattoo artists as well as interviews with their clients, allowing them to discuss their experiences and the personal meaning behind their tattoos. 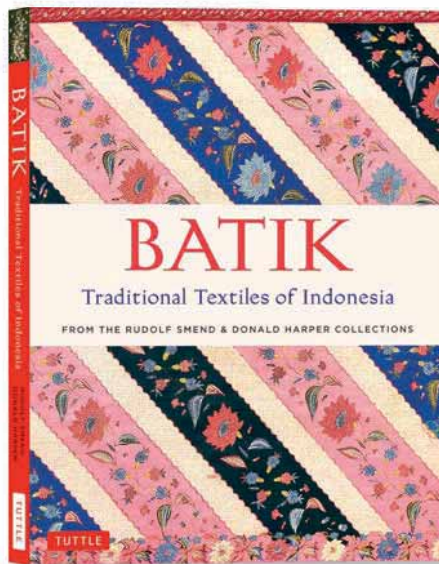

Donald Harper is an American collector of traditional textiles, particularly Indonesian batik.



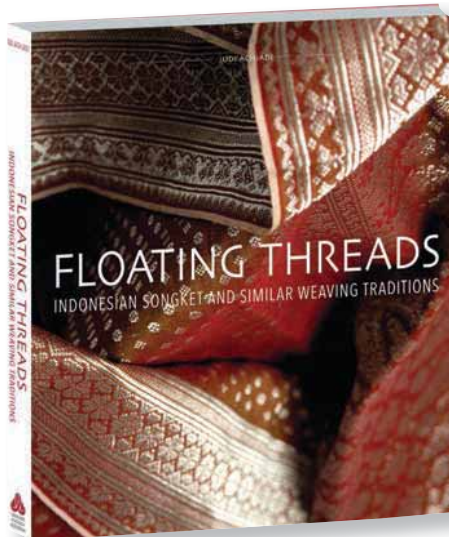

Indonesian textiles are most often associated with ikat and batik techniques, however float weave songket patterning represents an equally important part of the tradition. Produced throughout the Indonesian archipelago, float weave is a highly sophisticated hand-weaving technique that creates motifs in cloths using supplementary gold and silver threads.

Floating Threads presents a wide range of exquisite float weave textiles from the

19th century to the present day through hundreds of stunning photographs from leading Indonesian museums, (including the National Museum of Indonesia), foreign museums, and local collectors. The informative and fascinating text discusses both the history of the technique, including paths of distribution, as well as recent experimentations, illuminating the importance of contemporary fabrics to the continuation of Indonesia's precious textile traditions.

Canadian-born **Judi Achjadi** has written a number of articles and books on Indonesian art, including *The Glory of Batik: The Danar Hadi Collection*, *Exquisite Indonesia: The Finest Crafts of the Archipelago*, and *Batik Spirit of Indonesia*.

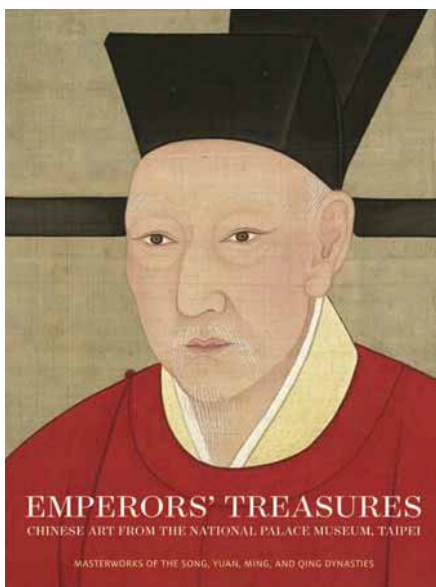

Emperors' Treasures presents selected masterworks from the National Palace Museum in Taipei, including paintings, calligraphy, bronzes, ceramics, lacquer ware, jades, and textiles, that exemplify the finest craftsmanship and imperial taste over the course of nine magnificent centuries.

This resplendent book explores the identities of eight Chinese rulers—seven emperors and one empress—who reigned from the early 12th through the early 20th centuries. They are portrayed in a story line that highlights artworks of their eras, from the dignified Song to the coarse yet subtle Yuan, from the brilliant Ming until the final, dazzling Qing period. *Emperors' Treasures* examines each ruler's distinct contribution to the arts and how each developed his or her personal aesthetic and connoisseurship.

The imperial collection of the National Palace Museum in Taipei is comprised of precious objects from the Song, Yuan, Ming, and Qing Dynasties. This renowned, historic Museum was formed shortly after the final Qing emperor was exiled in 1917 from works of art and cultural artifacts left inside the sovereign palaces. After years of political upheaval resulting in the frequent relocation of the collection to ensure its safety, it was moved to Taiwan in 1948. The permanent National Palace Museum site was built in Taipei in 1965.

Jay Xu is Executive Director of the Asian Art Museum of San Francisco.

Li He is associate curator of Chinese Art at the Asian Art Museum of San Francisco and a visiting research fellow at the Palace Museum, Beijing.

Contributions were made by Fung Ming-chu, Jay Xu, Ho Chuan-hsin, Alfreda Murck, Tianlong Jiao, Li He, and curators from the National Palace Museum and the Asian Art Museum.

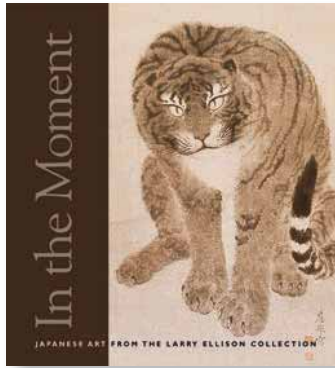

Inspired by an early love of Japanese gardens, Larry Ellison has assembled an impressive collection of Japanese art spanning some eleven hundred years of history. Highlights include a remarkable wood figure of Shotoku Taishi at age two, dating to the late 1200s or early 1300s; painted screens showcasing the use of classical Japanese and Chinese themes by Kano school artists in the late 1500s and early 1600s; and whimsical paintings of animals by innovative masters active in Kyoto in the 1700s.

The novel's title comes from the Indonesian phrase "jalan jalan," which one of the characters describes as: "Just fucking walking man. Out for a stroll." To Newbie, whose real name is only revealed on the book's final page, the phrase aptly sums up the emotional detachment he seeks. Fans of Alex Garland's *The Beach*, Elizabeth Gilbert's *Eat, Pray, Love*, Malcolm Lowry's *Under the Volcano*, and travel novels of all stripes will enjoy *Jalan Jalan's* descriptions of expat life in Indonesia and find themselves transfixed by Newbie's quest for salvation in an exotic land.

Mike Stoner has lived in Asia and Eastern Europe. He graduated with distinction from the MA program in Creative Writing from the University of Kent. He is married with two kids and currently lives in Kent, United Kingdom.
