

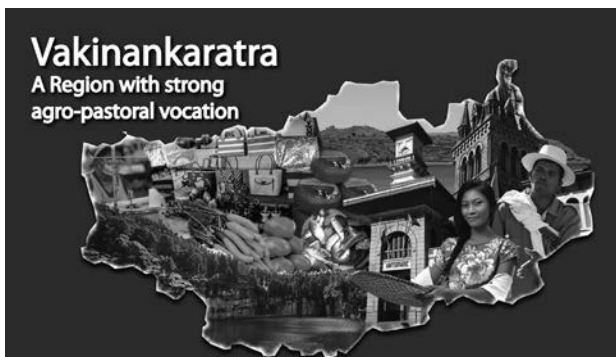

Faratsiho



- Located at an altitude of 1,720m, the highest town in Madagascar
- Area : 2,015 km²
- Constituted by 09 Communes
- Favorable to the cultivation of potatoes, wheat...
- Favorable to dairy cows
- Concentration of gemstone quarries

Mandoto



- Located at an altitude of 843 m
- Constituted by 09 Communes
- Area : 4,500 km²
- National migrant reception area
- Subsoil rich in precious metal, precious and semi-precious stones
- Favorable to temperate crops : rice, cassava, peas of bambara, peanuts and other intensive exploitation

Betafo



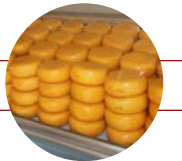
- Located at an altitude of 1,436 m
- Favorable to the cultivation of fruits and vegetables
- Surface area : 4,607 km²
- Consisting of 18 Communes
- Subsoil rich in precious metal, precious stones and semi-precious stones
- Numerous tourist sites, thermal water sources and thermal springs

Antsirabe II



- Located at more than 1,800 m of altitude
- Most populated district in the Region
- Area : 2,769 km²
- Consists of 20 Communes
- Favored by fruits and vegetables : potato, apple, carrot
- Subsoil rich in precious metal, precious stones and semi-precious stones
- Favorable to the dairy cow breeding
- Factory : cement factory, flour mill, agricultural machinery

Antsirabe I



- Capital of the Region, located at 1,500m of altitude, in a basin
- Surface area : 180 km²
- Constituted by 6 districts
- Antsirabe is the second industrial center of Madagascar : textiles and clothing, agri-food, tobacco and processing of essential oils. Several large companies are located in the region offering thousands of jobs
- Favorable to the cultivation of green vegetables
- Therapeutic thermal waters
- Nurseries

Ambatolampy



- Located at an altitude of 1,572m
- Area : 1,709 km²
- Constituted by 19 Communes
- 58% of the region's natural ecosystems
- Very rich in mineral resources
- Production of foie gras
- Mineral water factory, brewery
- Artisanal manufacture of kitchen utensils in aluminum

Antanifotsy



- Located at an altitude of 1,660 m favorable to food crops, poultry and dairy cows breeding
- Surface area : 3,425 km²
- Consisting of 14 Communes
- Small mines
- Handicrafts : basketry, embroidery, weaving, cartwrighting, pottery, sawmill

Climate

Tropical climate of altitude, favorable to temperate crops (fruits, potatoes), dry tropical crops (rainfed rice, onions), and dairy cattle breeding



Flora

242 floristic species distributed in 161 genera and 64 families (*orchidaceae*, *liliaceae*, *acanthaceae*, *fabaceae*, ...) including 26 species endemic to the Ibity massif only



Watersheds

Three major watersheds : Tsiribihina, Mangoro, Betsiboka



Wildlife

9 species of small mammals, 20 species of reptiles and 10 species of amphibians



Forest cover

49,595 Ha of forest cover, i.e. 2.8% of the total area of the Vakinankaratra Region



Water

Water, a natural resource in power : fishing (lacustrine and rice-fish farming) ; tourism (lakes Andraikiba, Tritriva and Tatamarina, Antafofo waterfall) ; hydrothermal deposit (41 thermo-mineral water sources : 1 in Ambatolampy, 13 in Antsirabe I and II, 20 in Betafo and 3 in Faratsiho) ; mineral water springs (Vichy and Royet type in full expansion, 9 not yet developed : 2 in Faratsiho and 7 in Antsirabe I and II)

Energy

Potential for "low energy" geothermal energy
Large potential for small hydroelectric sites : 92 MW





Agriculture Sector

Main speculations : food crops (rice, corn, manioc, potatoes...), industrial crops (wheat, barley, soybeans, sorghum...), vegetables and arboriculture.

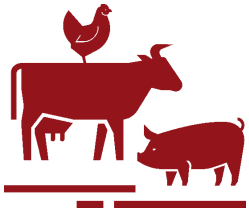
Potentialities :

- Available areas : 249,431 Ha
- 93% of agricultural households in the Region
- More than 900 irrigated perimeters
- Capacity for resilience to climate risks due to its geographical position
- Possibility of expanding cultivated areas in the West
- Geographical proximity to the Capital : considerable advantages in terms of access to national and international markets

Livestock Sector

Main livestock farming : cattle, pigs, goats, sheep and poultry
Priority sectors : milk and foie gras

Potentialities

- First cow's milk producing area in Madagascar (80%) : 45,000,000 liters/year
- Diversification of crops favorable to the feeding of dairy cows
- Access to a large market for poultry products : local and national (*via* Antananarivo)

- Three forms of fishing practicable : freshwater (36.1%), rice-fish(18%) and fish farming (16.5%)
- Production : 7,835 farmers - 1,405 Ha of land - 2,069.40 t of production/year on average
- 3,000,000 carp fry produced annually

Potentialities

- Still large local market : import of fish and seafood from other regions
- First carp fry producing region in Madagascar
- Operationalization of the Manjakatempo trout farming station

Antsirabe city :
Second industrial pole of Madagascar

Tourism Sector

Potentialities

- Very varied tourist sites (thermal sites, volcanic lakes, queen's palace, rural village tourism, geographical and cultural sites, etc. ...)
- Holiday destination
- Tourism and gastronomy : Foie Gras of Behenjy
- Crossroads to the South (RN7) and to the West (RN43 and 34) : obligatory passage for tourists
- Well-being tourism : thermal center (baths, massages...)



Handicrafts Sector

Handicrafts and their market value represent one of the most important activities ensuring the development of the tourism sector. Handicraft products : lapidary, basketry, silk, metal work, aluminum metal works, aluminum casserole, stone cutting, embroidery, raffia crochet, zebu horn transformation, silk.

Subsoil rich in precious metals, precious and semi-precious stones the majority of which are not yet exploited.

Current situation

- 65% of the quarries and mining operators in the province of Antananarivo
- About one hundred small-scale miners
- Exploitation and valorization of industrial mineral substances by cement factories

Potentialities

- Reserve of 23,000,000 tons of limestone
- A hundred tons of asbestos
- Untapped deposits of precious and semi-precious stones and gold

Energy Sector

Current situation

- 6/7 electrified districts in the Vakinankaratra Region
- 3 sources of energy : thermal, hydroelectric and solar power plants
- Supply the Interconnected Electric Network of Antananarivo : Medium Voltage Network : 420 km
Low Voltage Network : 400 km (covering 80% of the demand on Antsirabe Ville)

Potentialities

- Hydroelectric power stations of Sahanivotry (15 MW) and Ambatolampy (20 MW).
- Competitive electricity tariff for low voltages (1.30€/kWh)



Road Infrastructures

Current situation

- Current road infrastructure : 31,640 km, paved road : 6,933 km
- 20% of the region's communes are only accessible with trucks or 4wd vehicles in rainy periods

Potentialities

- Abundant materials for maintenance : quartzite, pozzolan...
- Low relief and solid platform : intervention can be limited to simple reprofiling
- Region well served by asphalted national roads linking the chief town of the Region with all the regions and provinces of Madagascar





Social Aspect

Vakinankaratra is the 2nd most populated region on a national scale, the population's living conditions improvement requires an integrated approach of several sectors.



DRINKING WATER

Water resources : 14,000 m³/day, or an average of 48 liters/day per person. The production rate of drinking water in the city is estimated at 80% : 8,500 subscribers and 162 standpipes (JIRAMA), water capacity supplied : 591000 m³.



HEALTH

Vakinankaratra is the 3rd best endowed region in terms of health infrastructures. It is not one of the most regions sensitive to food insecurity, but the chronic malnutrition rate of children under 5 is among the highest in Madagascar (51.9%).

Staff, equipment, and infrastructure

- 30 specialist physicians, 170 general practitioners, and 371 paramedics
- 208 health facilities : 65 CSB1, 142 CSB2, 03 CHRD1 and 01 CHR



EDUCATION

Vakinankaratra has more educated population compared to national level (primary school)

- Schooling rate : Primary : 90.85% - Junior high : 33.85 Middle school : 33.85% - High school : 18.41
- Literacy rate for those over 15 years old : 82,7 %
- Personnel: civil servants and contractual : 5,321 - non-civil servants : 12,642 - unqualified : 13,169
- Educational institutions : Primary: 2,462 - College: 511 - High school : 165 – LTP : 9 – CFP : 28 - University : 10.





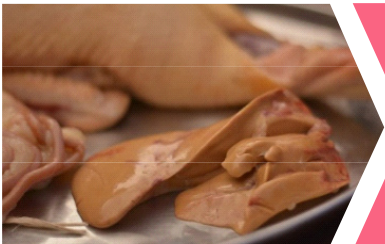
