

Attracting Excellence to Teaching Program Contract for Award Year 2020-21

1. AUTHORITY	
Ι,	, agree to the following terms and conditions of this contract
pursuant to the Excelle	nce in Teaching Act (Sections 79-8,132 through 79-8,140 of the Revised Statutes of
Nebraska (R.R.S.) and	the Nebraska Department of Education's Regulations Governing the Attracting
Excellence to Teaching	Program (92 Nebraska Administrative Code (NAC), Chapter 25).

2. AWARD FORGIVENESS

If I successfully complete the teacher education program and major for which the award was received, become certified pursuant to Sections 79-806 to 79-815 R.R.S. with an endorsement in the shortage area for which the award was received, and become employed as full-time teacher (as defined in 92 NAC Chapter 25, Sections 002.06 and 002.11) in an approved or accredited school in Nebraska within six (6) months of becoming certified, and otherwise meet the requirements of this contract, payments shall be suspended for the number of years that I am required to remain employed as a teacher in Nebraska under this contract.

Beginning after the first two years of teaching full-time in Nebraska, with at least a partial assignment in the shortage area for which the award was received, for each year that I teach in Nebraska, payments shall be forgiven in an amount equal to \$3,000, except if I teach in a school district that is in a local system classified in the very sparse cost grouping as provided in Section 79-1003 R.R.S. or teaching in a school building in which at least forty (40%) percent of the formula students are poverty students as provided in Section 79-1003 R.R.S., or if I teach in an accredited or approved private school in Nebraska in which at least forty (40%) of the enrolled students qualified for free lunches as determined by the most recent data available from the department, payments shall be forgiven each year in an amount equal to \$6,000.

3. REPAYMENT COMMENCEMENT

The following changes in status will result in repayment commencement within six (6) months of the change in status at the rate fixed pursuant to Section 45-103 R.R.S. accruing as of the date I sign this Contract:

- Failure to remain enrolled at an eligible institution (as defined below) or otherwise fail to meet the requirements of an eligible student (as defined below),
- Failure to be employed as a full-time teacher in an approved or accredited Nebraska school teaching
 at least a portion of the time in the shortage area for which the award was received for a time
 period equal to the number of years required for award forgiveness under the above laws and
 regulations,
 - If not employed as stated above, failure to become enrolled as a full-time student (as
 defined below) in a graduate program within six (6) months after obtaining an
 undergraduate degree for which a award from the program was obtained, or
- Failure to complete the requirements for graduation within five (5) consecutive years after receiving the initial award under the program.

Eligible institution shall mean a not for profit college or university which: (1) is located in Nebraska, (2) is accredited by the North Central Association Higher Learning Commission, (3) has a teacher education program, and if a privately funded college or university, has not opted out of the program pursuant to 92 NAC 25.

Eligible student shall mean an individual who a) is a full-time student; b) is enrolled in an eligible institution in an undergraduate or a graduate teacher education program working toward his or her initial certificate to teach in Nebraska; c) has been officially admitted to that teacher education program, pursuant to their administrative standards, d) if enrolled at a state-funded eligible institution, is a resident student as described in Section 85-502 R.R.S. or, if enrolled in a privately funded eligible institution, would be deemed a resident student if enrolled in a state-funded eligible institution; e) is a student majoring in a shortage area; f) graduated in the top quarter of his or her high school class or has a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0 on a four point scale in an eligible institution; g) agrees to complete a teacher education program at an eligible institution and to complete the major on which his or her eligibility is based; and h) commits to teach in an accredited or approved public or private school in Nebraska upon successful completion of a teacher education program at an eligible institution and becoming certified pursuant to Sections 79-806 to 79-816 R.R.S.

Full-time student shall mean in the aggregate, the equivalent of a student who in a twelve (12) month period is enrolled in twenty-four (24) semester undergraduate credit hours or eighteen (18) graduate credit hours of classroom, laboratory, clinical, practicum, or independent study course work.

4. REPAYMENT SCHEDULE

In the event I enter repayment, the award becomes a loan. If I must repay any part of or the entire loan, I will comply with the repayment schedule as provided by the Nebraska Department of Education. Repayment will be made on a monthly basis, allowing for two (2) years of payments for the total loan amount received from all loans under the Attracting Excellence to Teaching Program. Monthly payments must be received at the Department no later than the 15th day of each month. I may accelerate payments on all or any part of the loan principal plus accrued interest at any time without penalty.

5. PENALTY

In the event I fail to make a scheduled payment of any installment due, the entire unpaid indebtedness including interest due shall, at the option of the Commissioner, become immediately due and payable.

6. DEFERMENT

A deferment of the repayment period may be granted by the Commissioner according to 92 NAC 25, Section 002.05D2 if I meet one of the following conditions:

- A. Engaging in a full-time course of study at an institution of higher education;
- B. Serving on active duty as a member of the Armed Forces of the United States, for a period not in excess of three (3) years;
- C. Temporarily totally disabled as established by the sworn affidavit of a qualified physician, for a period not in excess of three (3) years;
- D. Unable to secure employment by reason of the care required by a disabled child, spouse, or parent for a period not in excess of twelve (12) months; or
- E. Seeking and unable to find full-time employment for a single period not to exceed twelve (12) months

7. DEFAULT

My failure to either fulfill the terms necessary for award forgiveness or repay the loan shall constitute a default. If I am in default, my debt may be referred to a collection agency according to Section 45-623 R.R.S.

8. CANCELLATION

The repayment obligation will be canceled if the Commissioner determines that I am unable to teach because I am permanently totally disabled, on the basis of verification from the Social Security Administration, or in the event of my death.

9. OTHER OBLIGATIONS

I am responsible for informing the Financial Aid Office of the institution in which I'm enrolled of the award under this program so that appropriate adjustments can be made to my financial aid package provided by the institution.

I am also responsible for informing the Nebraska Department of Education of changes to my name and other contact information, place of employment and/or employment status, and changes to the eligible program as identified in the approved AETP Application for Funds.
