And I would like to give a big thanks to Wayne Riggs, who has been our newsletter editor since the fall of 2017 – thanks, Wayne, for all your efforts.

Last month we had our first hybrid culture class and hybrid monthly meeting, both with some technical difficulties. There are lots of topics that would be of interest: orchid photography, your interesting way of growing orchids, how you care for your favourite types of orchids – really almost anything. Culture classes are meant to be a way to get us talking and sharing and learning from one another, so don't be shy!

We haven't finalized our plans for our November meeting, normally we held a pot-luck social and auction, but the pot-luck part of it is not practical under the current Covid conditions. But we will come up with something, so stay tuned!



# Jis Sebastian: Orchid Science in India: Current Perspectives & Future Challenges

Jis has worked in the Western Ghats, India's Western & Eastern Himalayas, involved in research, conservation, and community outreach. She is currently running research, conservation, and capacity-building programs in Orchid science and a climate-resilient, sustainable community model initiative in Idukki, Kerala.

#### Henry Oakeley: Orchid Hunting in Peru

Henry has been growing orchids for 65 years, concentrating on Lycaste, Ida, and Anguloa for nearly 50 years. He is a Physician Emeritus and Garden fellow for the Royal College of Physicians of London medicinal garden. For the past ten years, his primary interest has been the history and uses of medicinal plants.





# John Varigos: Borneo—Land of Wonder & Biodiversity

John, a pharmacologist and clinical trialist, has grown orchid species for over 40 years. He is an avid orchid photographer (over 20,000 photos on Flickr) and, for the past 20 years, has enjoyed traveling the world, trekking the jungles, and finding and photographing orchids in situ.

#### Jim Cootes: Orchid Species of the Philippines

Jim's interest in Philippine orchids started in the late 1970s when he visited the mountains of central Luzon. He saw many orchids that he could not identify, so he created a database. From this material, he has written 2 books and is working on the third volume as well as co-authored a book on Philippine dendrobiums.
