(CIS): NB P

- -What does CIS stand for? Commonwealth of Independent States
- -Before it was called Russia, what was it called? United Soviet Socialist Republics (USSR)
- -Where does the Trans-Siberian Railroad start and end? Starts in St.

Petersburg and ends in Vladivostok (Russian Navy Base)

- -Who ordered the railway to be built? Tsar Alexander III
- -What role did the railway hold in WW II? Huge role in WWII helping hundreds of European factories dismantle weapons and rebuild them in Asia
