

Update on outbreaks and clusters as of Jan 29th

- 63 Active outbreaks, 107 outbreaks have been resolved.
- There are currently 572 cases among residents and 367 cases among the facility staff in Congregate Care & Living as of January 29th and numbers seem to be rising, with that said numbers should get better as vaccinations continue in long term care facilities.




Testing


- Testing continues to happen at 19 sites a day throughout the state.
- Weekend Testing at the United Church, Feb 6th, 14th could be a Valentine's Day "date", 20th, 28th
- Testing continues to be offered almost daily in Barre, Northfield, Waterbury, Middlebury and Berlin.

Vaccination Planning

- Vermonters age 75 and older are eligible to receive their vaccine, this should take approximately 5 weeks from when the vaccines were first available. Next age group will be 70+, then 65+.
- Nearly 79% of those 75+ population have registered to get vaccinated; this does not include LTC facilities
- About 55,000 have been vaccinated in VT. Nearly 19,500 have completed their doses.
- Vermont is 2nd in the Northeast with 11.61 doses administered per 100 residents, VT is 8th in the country.
- More than 26,000,00 have been vaccinated nationwide, 6,000,000 have received 2 doses.
- Nearly 50,000,000 doses have been distributed nationwide
- Side effects are more likely with a second dose than a first, according to the U.S. Food and Drug Administration. Both the Pfizer-BioNTech and Moderna vaccines can cause muscle and joint pain, chills, fever, swelling and redness at the injection site, nausea, swollen lymph nodes and a general unwell feeling.
