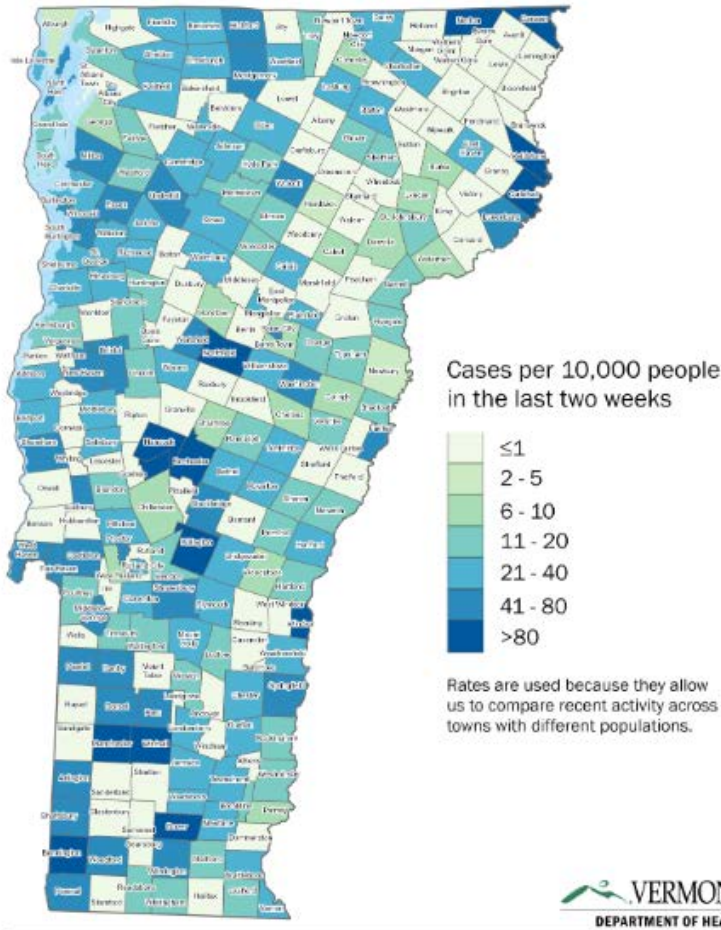

### **Update on outbreaks and clusters as of Jan 29<sup>th</sup>**

- 63 Active outbreaks, 107 outbreaks have been resolved.
- There are currently 572 cases among residents and 367 cases among the facility staff in Congregate Care & Living as of January 29<sup>th</sup> and numbers seem to be rising, with that said numbers should get better as vaccinations continue in long term care facilities.

### **Testing**

- Testing continues to happen at 19 sites a day throughout the state.
- Weekend Testing at the United Church, Feb 6<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup> could be a Valentine's Day "date", 20<sup>th</sup>, 28<sup>th</sup>
- Testing continues to be offered almost daily in Barre, Northfield, Waterbury, Middlebury and Berlin.

### **Vaccination Planning**

- Vermonters age 75 and older are eligible to receive their vaccine, this should take approximately 5 weeks from when the vaccines were first available. Next age group will be 70+, then 65+.
- Nearly 79% of those 75+ population have registered to get vaccinated; this does not include LTC facilities
- About 55,000 have been vaccinated in VT. Nearly 19,500 have completed their doses.
- Vermont is 2<sup>nd</sup> in the Northeast with 11.61 doses administered per 100 residents, VT is 8<sup>th</sup> in the country.
- More than 26,000,00 have been vaccinated nationwide, 6,000,000 have received 2 doses.
- Nearly 50,000,000 doses have been distributed nationwide
- Side effects are more likely with a second dose than a first, according to the U.S. Food and Drug Administration. Both the Pfizer-BioNTech and Moderna vaccines can cause muscle and joint pain, chills, fever, swelling and redness at the injection site, nausea, swollen lymph nodes and a general unwell feeling.

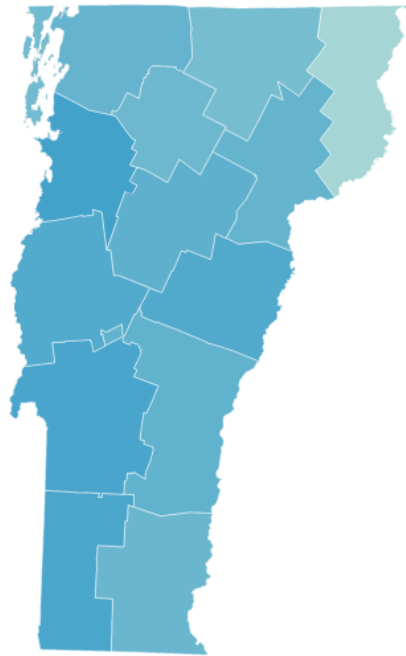

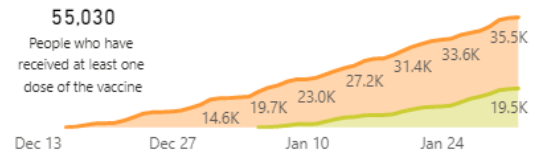

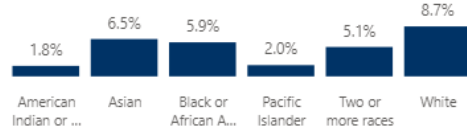


Show rates by Race/Ethnicity

#### By Race - Statewide

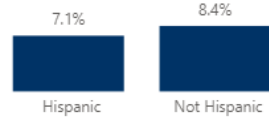
The percent of the Statewide population by race that has received at least one dose of the vaccine.



Race information is missing for 15% of people vaccinated.

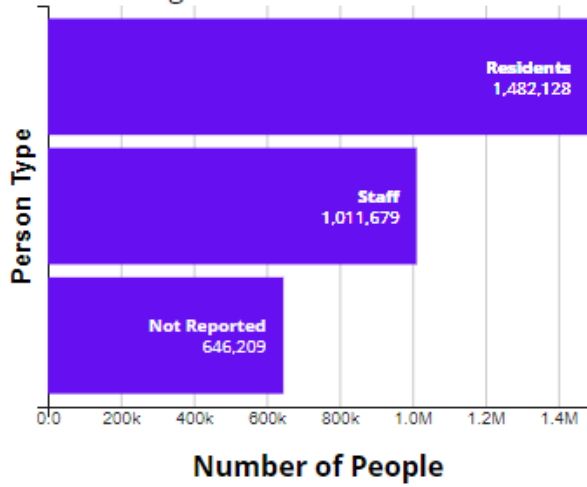
#### By Ethnicity - Statewide

The percent of the Statewide population by ethnicity that has received at least one dose of the vaccine.

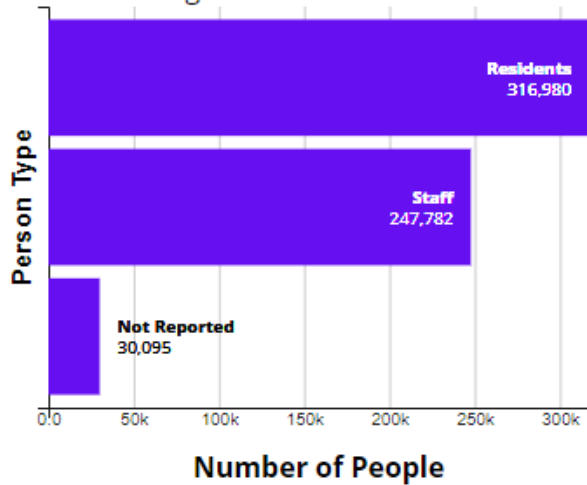


Ethnicity information is missing for 23% of people vaccinated.
