

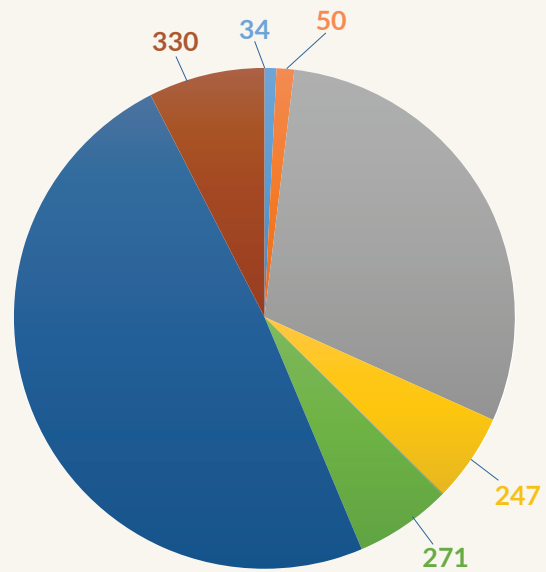

Amanda’s patients are at all stages of life. Although patients can be admitted to hospice with a prognosis of six months or less, some of her patients are admitted only weeks or days before their passing. “It’s hard not to get attached to my patients,” she says. “But I have to remember why I’m taking care of them—they are not going to get well and I don’t want them to feel afraid. But that doesn’t make their passing any easier.”

Hospice care is about making someone near the end of life as comfortable as possible. Our hospice team of nurses, therapists, physicians, social workers, chaplains, volunteers and bereavement specialists have not stopped—and if anything, are working and caring for our community harder than ever.

**Giving support to the hospice patients and families isn’t a job.  
It’s a reward.**

“The focus is on the patient and their families being as comfortable as possible. We create dignity and respect by supporting the unique needs and wants of the patient.” The focus on ensuring every patient receives a dignified experience, regardless of the pandemic, full of respect, love and compassion is the Hospice difference.

“Every day is different; every person is different, every need is different,” adds Amanda. “I do whatever they need. I provide whatever they need to ensure that the patient is comfortable and safe, the family is at ease and informed.”

**This is what Amanda also wishes people knew about Hospice.  
It isn’t sad.**

“Whenever I tell friends what I do, their response is always ‘Oh, that’s sad’. But it’s really not. I see beautiful, happy moments every day at Hospice. I consider it an absolute privilege to be a part of someone’s last months, weeks or days. The gratefulness for life is felt with every shift you work, every room you walk into. There’s a sense of peace at Hospice, and it’s absolutely beautiful.”
