- PART I -

(Chapters 1 to 39 inclusive)

NOTES :

1. This document includes products which can be regarded as the most representative items of trade between the Member States of the EEC and the third countries which are Contracting Parties to the General Agreement. This document has been prepared taking account on the one hand of the numerous specializations existing in the four tariffs, and, on the other hand, of the provisions of Article 19 of the Treaty.
2. The combination and very often the juxtaposition of different specializations, together with the obligation to compute the arithmetic average of the duties in the four tariffs lead to tariff constructions which are too complicated, and which will have to be adjusted to take account of trace and administrative requirements. Therefore, while the levels of duties mentioned in the specimen tariff will remain unchanged, the rates and wording of the sub-headings will be adjusted as necessary.
