





# Falconiformes (Falcons)

- Diurnal birds of prey
- Wings sharply pointed at tips
- Tooth on the upper mandible of the beak
- Vertical stripes before and/or behind the eye
- Streaking vs. barring on juveniles vs. adults

# Accipitriformes (Ospreys, Eagles, Hawks and Vultures)

- Diurnal birds of prey
- Large bodies and bills
- Osprey scales on feet, reversible outer toes
- Vulture long curved bills, weak feet, long wings (V)
- Hawks major species plus Accipiter and Buteo species (forest vs. open-country)



# Gruiformes (Rails, Gallinules, Coots and Cranes)

- Marsh birds
- Coots very aquatic, lobed toes to aid in swimming, forehead shield
- Cranes tall, long necks and legs, red plumage distinguishes from herons







## Charadriiformes (coastal water birds)

- Lapwings and plovers = small, long legs and short bills, black and white markings
- Oystercatchers = pink-red legs and feet, long bills flattened laterally
- Auks, murres and puffins = black and white colouring



# Charadriiformes (coastal water birds)

- Sandpipers brown/gray, pale bellies
  - length of bill relative to head
  - shape of bill
  - markings on the head
  - rusty colouring
  - colour and length of legs
- Gulls
  - colour of the bill
  - amount of black on upper wings
  - colour of the legs
  - body size
