Please accept one copy of the label for “Abluere Disinfectant Solution” (Reg. No. 87819-1) with the following minor changes highlighted:


1. Addition of statement, “Hold spray bottle 6-8” from surface.”

It is my understanding that these changes qualify as notifications per PR Notice 1998-10. Attached is three copies for the US EPA with the indicated changes included.

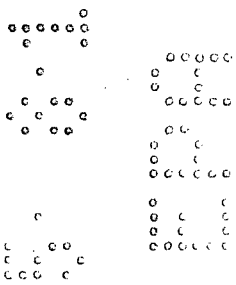
