I wanted to first highlight a few events that LED has been a participant partner in where we've recognized existing Louisiana businesses. In May, LED and SPA honored 2012 Small Business Award winners, and at that event, we honored leaders who make significant contributions through the Louisiana small businesses.

Later in June, we recognized excellence in manufacturing with our Lanyard Awards, and this award was established in 1979. It's recognized over 270



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louisiana manufacturing businesses since inception. We work with the Louisiana Quality Foundation and Louisiana Industrial Executives with that award. So over the last several months, we've been working with and honoring a number of our successful businesses and leaders with the small business space and will be very happy to continue those programs in that recognition.

We've added some recent recognitions as a state on a number of rankings that we think are important. Recently in June, the U.S. Chamber ranked Louisiana number one for export growth and number two for income growth. The Chamber Foundation said that positive workforce and policy are spreading the Louisiana economy, so great recognition for both awards from a policy standpoint.

We also recently -- this was actually in May, but we reached our highest rank ever in CEO Survey. CEO is a publication that's received by chief executive officers, and our state now ranks number 13th in their Best/Worst States For Business Survey. That's up 32 spots in the past four years. This is a ranking that's not based on fundamentals or policies in the state, but perception. So we have one ranking where we've seen some great recognition that are based more on policies, this is actually based on perception and how the State



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is viewed as far as business climate. So we're very excited to be making progress on both fronts there.

There have been a number of recent project announcements we're very excited about, for instance, Haynes International recently announced a \$37-million investment creating 19 new jobs in Bienville Parish. We announced Ameco actually is going to expend by 127 direct jobs. That's in Mandeville. In St. Tammany Parish, a number of significant industrial commitment to the State. Dyno Nobel announced a feasibility study for and \$800-million project in Jefferson Parish. Sempra secured a final agreement for a new \$6-million LNG facility in Southwest Louisiana. Shintech, SE Tyler is a sister company, announced a major investment in Iberville Parish, \$120-million investment. So a lot of exciting projects.

We do participate in the interim, in particular with the revised outlook for natural gas prices in the U.S. spurring a lot of interest and activity in our traditional petrochemical sector. We look at that as well. We've also seen a lot of interest in some of our target and emerging sectors, including our efforts in software space. We participate in more and more successes in those areas as well.

I'll be happy to answer any questions,



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and, once again, I want to thank you for your participation and contributions to economic development in the state, so thank you.

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


