



Distinguishing features: Fruit is swollen at the base. Most closely resembles *D. macounii*, it differs by having straight stalks on the fruit, linear to linear-oblanceolate (vs. oblanceolate to obovate) basal leaves. 1-4 (vs 3-13

flowered). Fruit with simple to 2-rayed hairs.
