

CARFEST SOUTH 2015

EVENT SUMMARY

CarFest South will operate for the fourth year in 2015, again taking place at Laverstoke Park Farm. The event will operate from Friday 28th to Sunday 30th August.

The event is the brainchild of Radio 2 breakfast show DJ Chris Evans and raises money for BBC Children in Need. It has a partner event, CarFest North, and between them they raised £1.5 million for the charity in 2014.

The festival has 4 key components - cars, music, food and families.

Cars:

This year we have changed our hill climb format! We still have the extended hill climb, however, we have swapped the sevens theme for the CarFest countdown! Never mind the Thunderbirds we've got the best countdown going from 12 down to F1, so expect to see the following categories! There will be a maximum of two track shows a day:

- 12. The Dirty Dozen Cars from Chris Evans' collection
- 11. Vintage Eleven A mixture of diverse classics
- **10.** Race Car Ten -BTTC Jason Plato, Paul Newman's nissan race car, and a two seater Formula 2 car
- 9. Iconic Nine Landmark cars
- **8.** Hot Rod Eight Britain's championship winning Hot Rods
- 7. Super Car Seven the very best current super cars
- **6. Rally Six** historic rally cars from the past 50 years
- **5. Furious Five** -Japanese retro and current super cars
- **4. Funky Four** Low Riders, pimped rides, beach buggies and custom classic camper
- **3. Dragster Three** includes a 250k Bentley Continental GT, Pro Chevy Street Drag FIAT Bubble Car

- **2. Dynamic Duo** two generations of Batman Cars (Adam West and Michael Keaton)
- **1. Formula one** -a collection of historic F1 cars including a rare Martin Donnelly Lamborghini Lotus
- 1. Around 30 car clubs will present their top 5 cars to show to the visiting public
- 2. We'll be celebrating the Anniversary of 60 years of Citroen, 50 years of the Ford Transit and 105 years of Alfa Romeo and have a parade of Ferrari's too!
- 3. Ferrari's Owners Club present over 50 Ferraris
- 4. The team at Classic Car Auctions (CCA) will be hosting an auction on <u>Saturday</u> <u>30th August</u> which will feature around 100 cars. Classic Car Auction will also be selling some cars where 100% of the sale will go to Children in Need.

Music:

Live music will operate from the main stage (two stages side by side) each evening. VISITOR NUMBERS

Ticketed visitors per day: 18,800, of which up to 9,000 are campers. Staff, crew, guests, artists etc total 4,999.

SEP will be providing the traffic management expertise again this year and are liaising with HCC Highways dept regarding the implementation of a one way system again this year and speed limits on the roads around the event.

Brand Events and Laverstoke are working with Overton Parish Council to organise footpath access for local residents to provide an alternative to the C29.
