JUGOSLAVS PRESS ON.

Attack Corinthian Troops on Austrian Side of Demarcation Line.

PARIS, May 2.—Seventeen thousand Jugoslav troops Monday night attacked Carpathian troops numbering 4,000 in the sectors of Arnoldstein, Villach, Rosenbach, and Rainer, says a Vienna dispatch to Zurich.

The result of the operations, the dispatch continues, was that the Jugoslavs by Tuesday evening had passed the demarcation line fixed by the Armistice Commission by six miles.

The Jugoslavs Wednesday crossed the Drave River at several points and cut the line to Arnoldstein and Klagenfurt, preventing communication between German Austria and Italy.
