#### **SEEDING AND MANAGEMENT:**

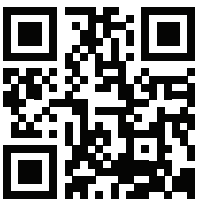
Pickseed recommends a seeding rate of 6 to 8 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. when used as a temporary home lawn, and 10 to 20 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. for overseeding applications.

#### **MOWING HEIGHTS:**

Recommended heights are 1/2" to 3". This allows you lots of options on golf course fairways and roughs, and as a sports turf. This also makes Quickdraw well suited for home lawns, parks, and for use around businesses and industrial lawns.

#### **BENEFITS:**

- Excellent for winter overseeding of dormant bermudagrass in both sports turf and landscape applications
- Transitions without chemistry, saving additional expenses
- Quicker and more uniform transition, making it easily managed on southern golf courses
- Superior nursegrass in blends with tall and fine fescues as well as Kentucky bluegrasses that may take longer to establish
- Excellent for sports turf repairs, especially in late fall or winter due to its ability to germinate in low soil temperatures
