

Wang Jingwei's Chinese Pan-Asianism

- Situation: Wang, longtime GMD politico, needed to legitimate his collaboration with the Japanese
- Action: Wang articulated a Chinese Pan-Asianism that bound together Sunist Chinese nationalism and Pan-Asian regionalism
- Specifics: Creating an Asian Sun Yat-sen, linking Sunist ideology to Pan-Asianism, practical arguments
- Contradistinction: Delegitimizing opponents and justifying Japanese invasion
 - CKS, the CCP, and Western Imperialism
