

AMENDEMENTS TO APPENDICES I AND II OF THE CONVENTION

adopted by the Conference of the Parties at
its seventh meeting in Lausanne, Switzerland,
from 9 to 20 October 1989

Interpretation:

- a. The abbreviation "spp." is used to denote all species of a higher taxon.
 - b. An asterisk (*) placed against the name of a species or higher taxon indicates that one or more geographically separate populations, subspecies or species of that species or taxon are included in Appendix I and that these populations, subspecies or species are excluded from Appendix II.
 - c. Two asterisks (**) placed against the name of a species or higher taxon indicate that one or more geographically separate populations, subspecies or species of that species or taxon are included in Appendix II and that these populations, subspecies or species are excluded from Appendix I.

6. The following populations of Crocodylus niloticus included in Appendix II subject to specified annual export quotas were maintained in Appendix II without being subject to such quotas (proposals submitted pursuant to Resolution Conf. 3.15 on Ranching):

Populations of Botswana, Malawi, Mozambique and Zambia.

7. The Conference of the Parties decided also:

- a. Not to annotate any FLORA species included in Appendix I so that artificially propagated hybrids produced from one or more of these species are traded with a certificate of artificial propagation, in accordance with Resolution Conf. 6.19, paragraph a), adopted at the sixth meeting of the Conference of the Parties.
- b. That the trade in seeds of CYCADACEAE spp. and ZAMIACEAE spp. listed in Appendix II not be subject to the provisions of the Convention.

- c. That the abbreviation "p.e." which denotes that a species is possibly extinct be placed against the species Cynolebias marmoratus and Cynolebias opalescens.
- d. That the symbol (~501) placed against Pteropus species included in Appendix II and meaning that dead specimens only are subject to CITES documentation and controls be deleted as contrary to Article I, paragraph (b), of the Convention.
8. Following the adoption of the amendments set out in items 1 to 4, the following species and other taxa are no longer listed as such in Appendix I or II of the Convention, since the amendments entered into force. Some species and taxa may, however, be included in either Appendix I or II under another taxon:

In accordance with the provisions of Article XV, paragraph 1, sub-paragraph (c), of the Convention, the amendments adopted at the seventh meeting of the Conference of the Parties entered into force 90 days after that meeting, i.e. on 18 January 1990 for all Parties except those which made a reservation by that date.
10. Following the adoption of these amendments a revised edition of Appendices I and II was prepared by the Secretariat. This revised edition is reproduced on pages 1043 to 1087 of the present Proceedings.

11. Some of the adopted amendments concern species or other taxa which were listed in Appendix III of the Convention. A revised edition of this appendix was therefore prepared by the Secretariat, which also entered into force on 18 January 1990. This revised edition is reproduced on pages 1089 to 1097 of the present Proceedings.
