AN ACT TO ABOLISH THE RATEABILITY OF CERTAIN
RENTS AS ON AND FROM THE 1st DAY OF APRIL, 1971,
TO AMEND SECTION 21 (3A) OF THE LOCAL GOVERN-
MENT ACT, 1946 AND FOR THE PURPOSE FIRST 10
MENTIONED TO AMEND CERTAIN OTHER ENACT-
MENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE OIREACHTAS AS FOLLOWS :

Abolition of
rateability of
certain rents.
1838, c. 56.

1.—(1) A person receiving rent in respect of a hereditament which
is exempted from rating under section 63 of the Poor Relief (Ireland) 15
Act, 1838, shall not be liable to be rated in respect of the rent, and
that section shall be construed and have effect accordingly.

(2) This section and *section 3* of this Act shall come into operation
on the 1st day of April, 1971.

2.—The period mentioned in section 21 (3A) of the Local Govern- 20
ment Act, 1946 (inserted by section 4 of the Local Government
(Temporary Reduction of Valuation) Act, 1960), is hereby extended
by one year and, accordingly, the reference in that section to the
period of ten years beginning on the 1st day of April, 1960, shall be
construed as a reference to the period of eleven years beginning on 25
that day.

Repeals.

3.—The enactments mentioned in column (2) of the Schedule to
this Act are hereby repealed to the extent specified in column (3) of
that Schedule.

4.—Everything done by a rating authority within the meaning of 30
the Local Government Act, 1946, before and in anticipation of the
enactment of this Act shall have and shall be deemed always to have
had all such (if any) validity and effect as it would have had if this
Act had been in force when such thing was done.

5.—(1) This Act may be cited as the Local Government (Rate- 35
ability of Rents) (Abolition) Act, 1971.

(2) The Local Government Acts, 1925 to 1968 and this Act, in so
far as it amends those Acts, may be cited together as the Local

(3) The Cork City Management Acts, 1929 to 1965, and this Act, 40
in so far as it amends those Acts, may be cited together as the Cork
City Management Acts, 1929 to 1971.

(4) The Local Government (Dublin) Acts, 1930 to 1967, and this Act, in so far as it amends those Acts, may be cited together as the Local Government (Dublin) Acts, 1930 to 1971.

(5) The Limerick City Management Acts, 1934 to 1955, and this Act, in so far as it amends those Acts, may be cited together as the Limerick City Management Acts, 1934 to 1971.

(6) The Waterford City Management Acts, 1939 and 1955, and this Act, in so far as it amends those Acts, may be cited together as the Waterford City Management Acts, 1939 to 1971.

10 (7) Subject to section 1 (2) hereof, this Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of April, 1970.
