1. Plaintiff and Defendant No. 2 jointly pray for a decree in terms of the settlement enumerated in paragraph Nos. 4 (a) to (d) of the application and additionally, in terms of paragraph No. 28 (a) of the amended Plaint. Defendant No. 1 already stand deleted. Plaintiff has given up the reliefs claimed in paragraph Nos. 28 (b) to (e) of the amended Plaint and Defendant No. 2 has agreed for the grant of relief under paragraph No. 28 (a) of the amended Plaint.

2. Counsels mentioned in the appearance above, confirm the settlement and pray that the suit be decreed in terms thereof. The aforementioned application



is duly supported by affidavits of the Authorized Signatories of the parties.
