

To the Senate and House of
Representatives,

Your joint Committee
to whom was referred the Petition
of the Merchants and others in
regard of preventing within the
Choctaw Nation the sale on Sundays
of goods wares or merchandise
excepting articles herein after
mentioned: And your Committee
would ask the adoption of the
following act.

An act entitled an act preventing
the sale of goods, wares or merch-
andise on Sunday.

Sec 1st Be it enacted by the General Co-
2 uncil of the Choctaw Nation Ass-
3 embled, That any person or persons
4 who shall expose goods wares or
5 merchandise on Sunday, shall be
fined Ten dollars with cost of
prosecution for every such offence
before the proper court having jurisd-
iction thereof: and all fines when
collected shall be paid into the Treas-
ury of the County, where the offender
was committed, for County purposes

Sec 2 Be it further enacted, That this act

shall not be so construed as to
prevent the sale of Medicine,
Burial cloths, or provisions to the
Travelling Community.

Sec 3rd Be it further enacted, That this act
take effect and be in force from
and after its passage.
