

Political neutrality behavior policy

December 2022



1. Purpose

The Board of Directors of Grenergy Renovables, S.A. ("GRENERGY" or the "Company") has the legal power to determine the Company's general policies and strategies.

Through this policy, Grenergy is committed to political neutrality. Grenergy's activities with respect to politicians, parties and various political offices will be non-partisan and will be based on the conclusion that such activities clearly support Grenergy's commercial interests and business objectives, always in compliance with the law and our internal rules of conduct.

2. Scope

The Political Engagement Policy applies to all Grenergy Group companies, including subsidiaries in which Grenergy has effective control or the possibility of effective control.

Likewise, this Policy applies in all geographies where Grenergy develops its operations, of any nature, i.e., in any geographical area and at any stage of the corporate value chain.

In the case of subsidiaries in which Grenergy does not have effective control, Grenergy will do its best to promote that the actions of such companies are aligned with the commitments set out in this document.

Likewise, Grenergy will make its best efforts and use its levers of influence to procure a behavior aligned with this Policy among its stakeholders, especially in the supply chain.

3. Principles of action

This policy prohibits donations, sponsorships or other contributions without consideration to political parties, political offices, or individuals who are members of political parties, or organizations related to any of these.

Likewise, Grenergy undertakes to disclose in its Sustainability Report the expenses incurred in hiring pressure groups or lobbyists, in the event that they are hired.

4. Whistle-blowing channel

In order to facilitate communication by any person, employee or not of Grenergy, regarding any breach of the principles described in this Policy, a whistleblower channel is provided on the website that guarantees confidentiality.



Grenergy undertakes to put in place mechanisms for the remediation of any identified non-compliance.

5. Public nature of the Policy

This Policy is public and will be permanently posted on the Grenergy website, as well as any subsequent modifications.

6. Approval and supervision of the Policy by the Board of Directors

This Policy has been approved by the Board of Directors, which will rely on the Audit Committee for the supervision of its compliance.
