Begonia 'Cocktail Series'

- <u>Use:</u> The Cocktail Mix Begonia is a glossy bronze leaf that produces pastel pink, red and white blossoms with touches of yellow in the center of bloom. The Begonia is a favorite of landscapers and homeowners alike. It is a compact plant that blooms all summer long and is very uniform in its habit. Very versatile and can be used in baskets, containers, garden beds, or in large landscape plantings. Landscapers love to plant the red begonias with Chartreuse Joseph coat for a brilliant contrast as in the photo to the left.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun-shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Brown leaf variety will tolerate more sun if the soil is not fantastic. Keep water off leaves and flowers.
- **Growth:** Grows 6-8" tall and 8-10" wide, maybe taller if deep shade or rich soil.
- Hardiness: Zone 9-11, Annual, Houseplant
- <u>Foliage</u>: We find the brown leaves to be more sun tolerant than the green leaved types.
- <u>Flower:</u> A multitude of blossoms from spring to fall make this one of the landscape plants for high impact color! Many colors to choose from in this series.
