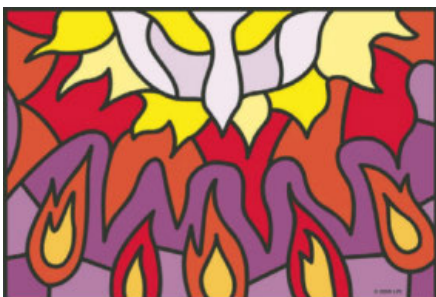

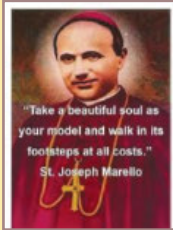

BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

The Story of the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary

This is a fairly late feast, going back only to the 13th or 14th century. It was established widely throughout the Church to pray for unity. The present date of celebration was set in 1969, in order to follow the Annunciation of the Lord and precede the Nativity of Saint John the Baptist.

Like most feasts of Mary, it is closely connected with Jesus and his saving work. The more visible actors in the visitation drama (see Luke 1:39-45) are Mary and Elizabeth. However, Jesus and John the Baptist steal the scene in a hidden way. Jesus makes John leap with joy—the joy of messianic salvation. Elizabeth, in turn, is filled with the Holy Spirit and addresses words of praise to Mary—words that echo down through the ages.

It is helpful to recall that we do not have a journalist's account of this meeting. Rather Luke, speaking for the Church, gives a prayerful poet's rendition of the scene. Elizabeth's praise of Mary as "the mother of my Lord" can be viewed as the earliest Church's devotion to Mary. As with all authentic devotion to Mary, Elizabeth's (the Church's) words first praise God for what God has done to Mary. Only secondly does she praise Mary for trusting God's words.

Then comes the Magnificat (Luke 1:46-55). Here, Mary herself—like the Church—traces all her greatness to God.

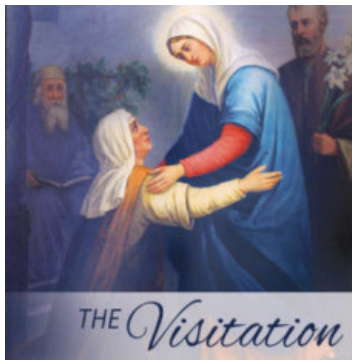
Reflection

One of the invocations in Mary's litany is "Ark of the Covenant." Like the Ark of the Covenant of old, Mary brings God's presence into the lives of other people. As David danced before the Ark, John the Baptist leaps for joy. As the Ark helped to unite the 12 tribes of Israel by being placed in David's capital, so Mary has the power to unite all Christians in her son. At times, devotion to Mary may have occasioned some divisiveness, but we can hope that authentic devotion will lead all to Christ and therefore, to one another.

La Historia de la Visitación de la Santísima Virgen María

Esta es una fiesta bastante tardía, que se remonta solo al siglo XIII o XIV. Se estableció ampliamente en toda la Iglesia para orar por la unidad. La fecha actual de celebración se fijó en 1969, para seguir a la Anunciación del Señor y preceder a la Natividad de San Juan Bautista.

Como la mayoría de las fiestas de María, está estrechamente relacionada con Jesús y su obra salvadora. Los actores más visibles en el drama de la visitación (ver Lucas 1:39-45) son María e Isabel. Sin embargo, Jesús y Juan Bautista roban la escena de forma oculta. Jesús hace saltar de alegría a Juan, la alegría de la salvación mesiánica. Isabel, a su vez, está llena del Espíritu Santo y dirige palabras de alabanza a María, palabras que resuenan a través de los siglos.



Es útil recordar que no tenemos el relato de un periodista sobre esta reunión. Más bien, Lucas, hablando en nombre de la Iglesia, da una interpretación de la escena de un poeta en oración. La alabanza de Isabel a María como "la madre de mi Señor" puede verse como la devoción de la Iglesia primitiva a María. Como toda devoción auténtica a María, las palabras de Isabel (la Iglesia) primero alaban a Dios por lo que Dios ha hecho con María. Solo en segundo lugar

alaba a María por confiar en las palabras de Dios.

Luego viene el Magnificat (Lucas 1:46-55). Aquí, María misma, como la Iglesia, atribuye toda su grandeza a Dios.

Reflexión

Una de las invocaciones en la letanía de María es "Arca de la Alianza". Como el Arca de la Alianza de antaño, María trae la presencia de Dios a la vida de otras personas. Mientras David danzaba ante el Arca, Juan el Bautista salta de alegría. Así como el Arca ayudó a unir a las 12 tribus de Israel al ser colocada en la capital de David, María tiene el poder de unir a todos los cristianos en su hijo. A veces, la devoción a María puede haber ocasionado cierta división, pero podemos esperar que la auténtica devoción nos lleve a todos a Cristo y, por lo tanto, a los unos a los otros.

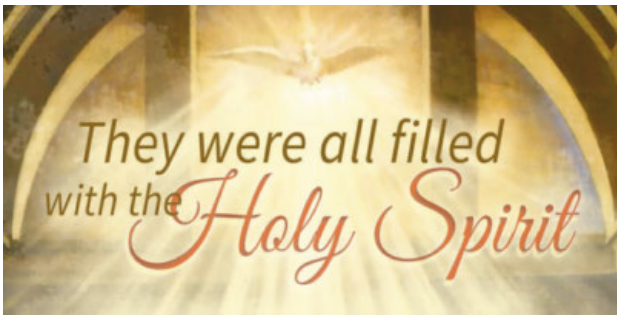
