*'Meidenbenne'*

**Hybrid Tea**

The world renowned Meiland International bred this one-of-a-kind Hybrid Tea. The velvety texture of the petals and unique color will be an instant success in your garden. A wonderful addition to any cutting garden, this rose is sure to stand out. Will last up to two weeks in a vase!



Black Baccara™ is a **Florist Rose**. For more than half a century, Star® Roses and Plants has introduced some of the most successful roses in the florist trade. Although only a few of the thoroughbreds introduced over the years have what it takes to survive outside of the perfect conditions found in the grower's greenhouse, the varieties that do make it into the garden trade provide some of the most refined blooms to be found.

An excellent specimen for cooler weather.

Recipient of the Rome Gold Medal. More vigorous than most of its kind.

## Peace Hybrid Tea



The world's most famous and beloved rose, in brilliant yellow and pink was first introduced to the U.S. by Star® Roses and Plants over 60 years ago. Developed by Meilland International on the eve of World War II, a clipping of the rose made its way from France to the Conard-Pyle Co. for safekeeping during the war. Coincidentally, the AARS named Peace its only winner for 1946 on the same day Japan surrendered, effectively ending the war. More popular today than when it was first introduced. Voted into the Rose Hall of Fame by the World Federation of Rose Societies in 1976 and later as the Rose of the 20th Century.

This variety has particularly beautiful blooms. The buds open to reveal many petalled cups, which gradually form large, flat rosettes. The color is a very attractive shade of soft yellow, the petals paling prettily towards the edges. The flowers have a medium strength fragrance, which is a perfect balance of Tea and myrrh. It will quickly reach some height and still produce flowers and leaves lower down the plant. Ideal for 10' wall or fence, obelisk or pillar, or front of the house. Named after the pilgrims in Chaucer's Canterbury Tales.

Named after the gothic revival house in Twickenham, London, built by Horace Walpole.

A particularly free-flowering climber, producing impressive displays of blooms into fall. The refined rosette flowers are rich yellow at the center, fading to palest yellow on the edges. Ideal for a 10' Wall or Fence, Obelisk or Pillar. Named for Mr. Ulrich Meyer, after his wife Georgia – both are German media personalities.

## **The Alnwick Rose®**

*Ausgrab*

### **English Shrub Rose**

Pretty, rich pink, cup-shaped buds gradually open to broad, full-petalled, shallow cups. The fully open blooms are soft pink and have an Old Rose scent, with just a hint of raspberry. The growth is bushy and relatively upright. Named for The Alnwick Garden in the UK.

## **English Shrub Rose**

Red buds open to beautifully formed, upward-facing, coral-pink rosettes. Small petals of varying shades mingle to provide a most pleasing effect. The myrrh fragrance has delicious hints of hawthorn, elderflower, pear and almond. It forms an upright shrub. Charles II hid in an oak tree at Boscobel House during the English Civil War. Bred by David Austin.

## **Carding Mill®**

*Auswest*

### **English Shrub Rose**

Large blooms in shades of pink, apricot and yellow are deeply cupped, overall, giving the impression of rich apricot. At the bud stage, when the petals are just starting to unfurl, the inside of the petals are a very rich, deep apricot as opposed to the paler, soft yellow undersides. When fully open the center of the flower is well filled with petals, their closeness giving the impression of a rich, apricot - pink.

Around the center, the loose ring of petals curl in slightly and so show their pale apricot yellow undersides. It will quickly make a lovely, bushy, rounded shrub with quite straight stems, the many flowers nodding just slightly. There is a strong and beautiful myrrh fragrance. 'Carding Mill' is an excellent, vigorous, medium-sized shrub. Carding Mill is an extremely beautiful valley in the Long Mynd just to the west of the David Austin nursery in Shropshire. Enjoys warmer climates. Bred by David Austin.

They are yellow in color, tending almost towards mustard, and have a strong, delicious fragrance, varying between soft floral Tea and pure lemon. It makes a sturdy shrub with broad, spreading growth. Named after the naturalist who was born in Shropshire where our UK nursery is located.

Bears exquisite yellow flowers. These start off beautifully cupped, later opening out to form rosettes.

Each bloom is packed with numerous small petals, arranged around a classic button eye. It has excellent green foliage and a compact, bushy habit with even, upright growth. Dedicated to David Austin Senior's granddaughter. Bred by David Austin.
